Decision of WRC:

The Committee noted that a complaint dated 16.08.2021 forwarded by Complaint Division of NCTE HQs., New Delhi vide their letter No.NCTE-C/PG011/118/2021-Complaint –Section-HQ/101748 dated 07th September, 2021 & followed by letter dated 03rd January, 2022, (2) A compliant dated 25.08.2022 forwarded by Complaint Division of NCTE HQs., New Delhi vide their letter No. NCTE-C/PG011/100/2022-Complaint –Section-HQ/113033 dated 12th August, 2022 followed by letter of even number/114291 dated 18th October, 2022 regarding serious allegations are made being irregularities about land and building (Infrastructure) and instructional facilities in this recognized institution together with fake documents produced by the institution for grant of recognition from WRC-NCTE. The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution is required to submit certified Land Documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed that the letter was issued to the institution on 14.05.2025 and First Show Cause Notice issued to institution & concerned on 14.05.2025. The institution has submitted reply of First Show Cause Notice received in WRC office on 31.05.2025. The Committee further noted that the reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:

- (i) The institution has submitted a photocopy of affidavit claiming that it is functioning from its existing premises and not shifted to its new premises till date. The institution is required to submit the affidavit in original along with all the land documents of the existing premises.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes, if any.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) It is observed from the documents attached that the institution has been functioning at the same premises where Gyanveer University is situated. The shifting was allowed by WRC in its 402nd Meeting held on 27th March, 2024 and subsequently order was issued on 10th April, 2024. In such case, the institution is to clarify why Gyanodaya Mahavidyalaya was shifted to the place where Gyanveer University is located.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit the land details of Gyanodaya Mahavidyalaya with reference to the new proposed name of the institution, School of Physical Education as per the NCTE Rules and Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution is required to clarify that presently the institution is affiliated with which university as the affiliation is observed from Dr. Hari Singh Gour University, Sagar, Madhya Pradesh and NOC is issued by Maharaja Chhatrashal Bundelkhand University, Chhattarpur, Madhya Pradesh.
- (iv) As per the prevailing norms of UGC, no private university can affiliate any of the institution whereas it is observed that whatsoever NOC is issued by respective university for getting it affiliated with Gyanveer University.
- (v) It is evident from the documents made available to the NCTE states fact that the institution has shifted from the place where it was functioning to the campus of Gyanveer University. If it is not so, the institution is required to submit all details of land in respect to it was functioning earlier and it has been functioning after shifting order.
 - a) The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Committee noted that the certain documents regarding shifting of premises and change of name of the institution were sought vide WRC letter of even no. dated 13.12.2024 from the institution. The institution vide its letter dated 15.01.2025 has submitted reply along with relevant documents followed by letter dated 11.04.2025 along with a court order dated 07.04.2025 of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in W.P.(C) No. 4264/2025 – Nobel College & ANR. versus NCTE & ANR. The Committee further noted that the reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:

- (i) Blue Print of the Building Plan is not submitted instead of that Scanned copy is submitted and the same is not approved by the Competent Govt. Engineer and running Courses pertaining to teacher education are also not earmarked therewith. Khasra Nos. are mentioned Building Plan instead of Survey Nos. The institution is required to submit Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes, if any.
- (ii) The institution has not submitted current Non-Encumbrance Certificate of the proposed land and building where it intends to shift. The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iii) The institution has submitted land utilizations certificate or Land Use Certificate and Building Safety Certificate, name of the institution is not mentioned therein and the same is not approved by the Tahsildar of the area under whose jurisdiction the location of land falls. The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.

- (vii) The details of existing recognized teacher training programmes and other courses by the institution are not mentioned in the submitted NOC issued by the competent affiliating body/ies. The institution is required to submit NOC of the Affiliating University as well as State Government regarding proposed change of name of institution and shifting of premises.
- (viii) In the affidavit submitted by the stakeholders, photographs are not affixed thereon and certified copy of the details of stakeholders in the By-laws for cross verification from the affidavits is not submitted by the society. The institution is required to submit individual affidavit of members of the society /trust on notarized Non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.10/-

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time. The Committee noted that the Show Cause Notice vide WRC/NCTE/APW01500/423003/408th/B.Ed./CN-58209/2024/52-55 dated 16.12.2024 was issued to the institution. The institution has submitted the reply of Show Cause Notice vide letter Ref.No.PCE/301 dated 28.12.2024 received in the office of WRC on 08.01.2025 & vide Ref. No. PCE/306 dated 10.01.2025 received in the office of WRC on 17.01.2025 & 07.02.2025 along with certain documents. The Committee further noted that the reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:

- (i) The institution has not submitted the latest list of teaching staff approved by its affiliating body. It has submitted the copy of same list of teaching staff which was submitted for the academic session 2015-2016. It is observed that the faculties at Sl. No. 1,4, & 5 are **NOT** approved by affiliating body. The age of staff at S.No. 01 is 72 years which is not in accordance with NCTE norms. The Principal has not been designated. The institution is required to upload the latest list of teaching staff countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body in the prescribed format of NCTE as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The name and designation of the issuing authority of Mutation Certificate is not mentioned on it. The land area is mentioned 13.25 (Measuring unit not mentioned). The institution is required to upload Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution has submitted copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued on (Date not visible) under the digital signatures of Sub-Registrar, Pernem, wherein the total land area is mentioned 1325 (Measuring unit not mentioned). The institution is required to upload

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time. The Committee noted that the **Final Show Cause Notice** vide letter No.WRC/NCTE/CF-15704/APW00799/123133/B.ED./410th/2024/182-184 and **Show Cause Notice** vide letter No. WRC/NCTE/CF-15704/APW00799/123133/B.ED./410th/2024/185-187 was issued to the institution on **24.01.2025**. The institution has submitted its reply to the Final Show Cause Notice vide letter No. CSU/MUM/ADMN/2024-25/568 dated 07.02.2025. The Committee further noted that reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:

- (i) The university has **not mentioned** the demarcated land area and built-up area for conducting the B.Ed. course in the land documents i.e. Building plan, NEC, CLU, BCC etc.
- (ii) In support of land documents, the university has submitted termination of Indenture of Lease Deed dated 19th March, 2008 Sant Upasani Maharaj Bahuudeshiya Sevabhavi Sansthan and the Director, Central Sanskrit University i.e. Private lease deed, which is not in accordance with the provision 8 (4) of NCTE Regulations 2014, amended vide NCTE Regulations, 2017 (Notification dated 28.04.2017) which stipulates as under :-

“2 b (4) No institution shall be granted recognition under these regulations unless the institution or society sponsoring the institution is in possession of required land free from all encumbrances on the date of application and the said land shall be either on ownership basic or on lease form the Government or Government institution for a period of not less than thirty years subject to the relevant laws of the concerned State or Union Territory.

Provided that in cases of Central or State Government Institutions or Universities, recognition may be accorded for a period of five years, on land or premises, which is leased to them.

Provided further that such institutions shall be required to shift to premises with own land and building thereon, in conformity with the specification in these regulations within a period of five years from the date of recognition.

Provided also that in case of Central or State Government Institutions or Universities, recognition may be accorded on land or premises, which is leases to them for a period of thirty years or more.”

- (iii) As the land where the university has proposed to shift is not acceptable as per NCTE Regulations 2014, the other documents related to land and building are also not acceptable.
- (iv) The university has submitted Non-Encumbrance Certificate but same is not issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- (v) The institution has not submitted Certified copy of Site Plan with demarcated land area for running different education courses.
- (vi) The university has submitted Building Completion Certificate but same is not in prescribed format and not signed by the Competent Government Authority.
- (vii) The university has not submitted Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) Status of NAAC accreditation is not submitted by the institution.

In view of the above, the permission of the institution for shifting of premises is refused.

<p>The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time. The Committee noted that the Final Show Cause Notice vide No.WRC/NCTE/CF-86449/APW03737/123434/B.ED./413th/2025/362-366 dated 05.03.2025 was issued to the institution. The institution has submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice vide letter vide No. 22720125 dated 25.03.2025 with certain documents. The Committee further noted that the reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:</p>			
(i)	The list of teaching staff submitted by the institution is neither approved by the affiliating body and nor in the NCTE prescribed format available on official website of WRC. The Aadhar Card Nos. of teaching faculties are not mentioned in the submitted list of teaching staff.		
(ii)	The affidavits on Rs.10 Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of individual teaching faculty are not submitted by the institution.		
(iii)	The institution has submitted the faculties details and it is noted that the institution has not appointed the 04 faculties for Perspectives in Education, 02 faculties for Pedagogy (Math), 01 faculty for Science and 01 faculty for Social Science as per NCTE Norms and Standards for M.Ed. course (Appendix-5) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.		
(iv)	The details of Ph.D. in Education or in any pedagogy subject is not mentioned. In Sr. No. 2 (Teaching Staff) Asst. professor have M.A. with 50% which is less than the required marks. In Sr. No. 11 Asst. Professor is not having Teacher Education degree and Sr. No. 12 is not having Post Graduate degree.		
(v)	The institution has not submitted Affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper by the authorized person of the management for appointment of Teaching Staff.		
(vi)	The institution has also not submitted on Rs.10 Non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.		
(vii)	The institution has submitted Bank Statement (Bank of India) of the Siddhivinayak Shikshan Prasarak Mandal for the period of 01.04.2024 to 15.03.2025 regarding salary disbursement of its teaching staff (1+16) shows entry as follows:-		
(viii)	Feb 2025 Rs.2,53,800/-, Jan 2025 Rs.2,54,860/-, Dec 2024 Rs.1,92,308/-, Nov Rs.1,92,308/-, Oct 2024 Rs.1,92,308/- & Rs.8,000/-, Sep 2024 Rs 1,92,308/- & Rs.8,000/-, Aug 2024 Rs.1,92,308/- & 8000/-, July 2024 Rs.1,67,632/- & arrears Rs.23,876/- and May 2024, Rs.1,92,380/-. It is not clear whether salary paid to its teaching staff as per guidelines of UGC/State Govt. or not” The institution has submitted pay-bills for the month of Feb 2025 net amount show total salary Rs.4,16,400/- and net salary is Rs.4,00,404/-. In the bank statement Rs.2,53,800/- is reflected and salary bill for the month of Feb, 2025 net salary reflected Rs.4,00,400/- is not tallying.		
(ix)	The institution has submitted Building Plan dated 22.06.2006 for Rawate Compound C.T.S. 8, S.No. 158 (Part) Taluka: Kurla, Total built up area- 37966.50Sq.ft. and Total land area is not mentioned in the Building plan approved by Up-Pramukh Abhiyanta, Mumbai Mahanagar Palika and Executive Engineer. The institution has submitted True Copy of Site Plan approved by J.B. Bankar Adv. & Notary (15205).		
(x)	The institution has submitted copy of letter dated 12.02.2020 in regional language claiming land use. The institution has not submitted Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra/Survey/Plot Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.		
(xi)	The institution has submitted True Copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate dated 02.01.2020 C.T.S. No. 8 (Part) Survey No. 158 (P) of village Bhandup approved by

- Tahsildar, Kurla Mulund. The land area is mentioned 520059 Sq. Yrd. and built-up area 35260.25 Sq.ft., the built-up area which does not match with Building Plan.
- (xii) The institution has submitted stability report dated 13.01.2024 issued by Private Chartered Engineer instead of Building Safety Certificate. The institution has not submitted Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (xiii) The institution has submitted copy of Govt. license to M/s. Fire link Services LLP with the copy of Certificate dated 19.03.2025 and certified that inspection report of fire prevention and Life Safety measures installed in the building during the period 01.07.2024 to 31.12.2024 and submitted Certificate to certify that the Fire Extinguishers installed in the clinic of S.S.P.M., R.K. B.Ed. College approved by Fire link Services LLP, date of refilling is 18.03.2026. The institution has not submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Maharashtra verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Maharashtra.
- (xiv) The institution has not submitted Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (xv) The institution has submitted True Copy of Building Completion Certificate dated 14.01.2020 approved by Asst. Engineer, 'S' Ward Assistant Commissioner Office, Bhandup however, the same is not prescribed format of NCTE (17 points). The built-up area mentioned in it is 30755.50 Sq.ft. which does not match with NEC, BCC and Building plan.
- (xvi) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that a letter issued to the institution with direction to submit reply/documents supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of the letter.
