Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided as under:

Complaint received as per matter given in complaint. The institution should be forwarded the copy of the complaint for rectification from the institution with direction to submit point-wise reply on the complaint supported with an affidavit and relevant documents in the complaint matter within 21 days from the date issue of letter.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time. The Committee noted that the institution has submitted reply vide their letter No. S.No./NCTE/2025/253 dated 11.03.2025 received in this office on 21.03.2025 in compliance of WRC's letter No.WRC APP1343/B.ED./413th/CG/2025/308/310 dated 27/2/2025 in connection with shifting of premises of the institution. The Committee further noted that the reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:

- (i) The institution has submitted resolution of the trust regarding shifting of premises on the letter head of the trust instead of extract of resolution book of the trust namely Shri Rawatpura Sarkar Lok Kalyan Trust.
- (ii) Plan of Khasra No.63/3 (0.5990 hectare) has been submitted but Plan of Khasra No. 63/2 (2.0230 hectare) has not been submitted.
- (iii) Submitted Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) is issued on 16.06.2023 by the Deputy Registrar, Dhamda, District-Durg, Chhattisgarh. The present NEC is not notarized and date mentioned thereon expired after 6 months of the date of issue. The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) mentioning all relevant details issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) Submitted Land Use Certificate is not issued by the Competent Government Authority i.e. SDM/Tehsildar of that area under the location of the Institution where it is established. The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority and mentioning the building is situated on a single plot.

- (v) The institution has submitted certified photocopy of land document pertaining to Khasra No. 63/2;63/3; and 63/5 respectively instead of original certified copy of land document issued by Revenue Department. The institution is required to submit certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority
- (vi) Site Plan and Layout Plan is not approved/issued over the seal and signature of the Competent Government Authority that i.e. SDM/Tehsildar.
- (vii) The institution is required to submit Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes, if any.
- (viii) Submitted Building Completion Certificate is not issued and approved by the Competent Government Engineer as well notarized. The institution has not submitted latest notarized Building Plan approved by the Competent Government Authority i.e. Competent Government Engineer. The institution is required to submit latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (ix) The institution has submitted non-judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- over the signature of Secretary of Trust but details of land and building area are not mentioned according to the submitted documents.
- (x) List of faculties approved by Hemchand Yadav University, Durg, Chhattisgarh is not submitted in the prescribed format of NCTE (Available at official web-site of WRC). One Principal individual affidavits of all stakeholder/members of the trust regarding resolution for shifting for premises of the institution. 01 Principal and 09 Faculty/ies available in the institution which are less than prescribed in the Norms as per Clause-5 of Appendix-4 of NCTE Regulation, 2014. Further, appropriate details of subject of pedagogy/ies are also not expressed. The faculty/ies are approved vide letter No. 545/Acad/Pari. 28/2018 dtd. 01/10/2018 by the Registrar, Hemchand Yadav University, Durg, Chhattisgarh that means the institution is also deficient since 2018 and running beyond the provisions of NCTE implemented through its Regulation, 2014 (Amended from time to time).
- (xi) The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (xii) The institution is required to submit Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Chhattisgarh verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Chhattisgarh at URL https://firenoc.cg.gov.in/Track Application.aspx
- (xiii) The institution is required to submit the latest list of teaching staff countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body in the prescribed format of NCTE as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
- (xiv) The institution is required to submit the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
- (xv) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Appellate Authority passed an Order vide No. 89-30/E355145/2025 Appeal/2nd Meeting,2025: ApplWRC202514892 dated 12.03.2025 and decided as under:

"After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the implunged order dated 17.12.2024 of WRC, NCTE with the direction to revisit the case in totality and also to check that the institution fulfil all the criteria of norms & standards for the land & building and if needed the WRC may also conduct the inspection of the institution to verify the infrastructural & instructional facilities as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time, and decision taken accordingly. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per direction given herein above."

As per the direction of the Appeal Committee, the order of WRC i.e. NCTE/WRC/APW00773/123107/B.Ed./408th (Part-I)/MH/2024/77-85 was issued to the institution on 17.12.2024 has been withdrawn.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Visiting Team be constituted in order to ascertain and scrutinize all the essential documents and at the time of verification, VT shall also check/verify student list year-wise (I,II,III,IV), website and Fire Safety Certificate so as to assess institution's preparedness for running the course as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Committee considered the matter and decided that Shree Swaminarayan B.Ed. College be allowed to be the constituent unit of Swaminarayan University, Kalol, Dist. Gandhinagar, Gujarat from the academic year of de-affiliation from the previous university i.e. Gujarat University, Ahmedabad. The institution to be informed accordingly and copy be endorsed to all authorities concerned.

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with legal opinion dated 20.06.2025 of Legal Division, WRC, the Committee observed as under:

On considering the request of the institution to close and withdraw the recognition of its B.Ed. course vide letter dated 10.07.2023, the Committee in its 392nd Meeting held on 22.08.2023 decided that recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed. course be withdrawn from the end of the next following academic session. Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued on 30.08.2023.

Being aggrieved by the withdrawal order dated 30.08.2023, the institution had preferred an appeal and the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat vide Order No. SCA 19764/2023 dated 08.11.2023 decided that "... 4. By way of ad-interim relief, further execution of the order dated 30.08.2023 is hereby stayed."

In the 413th WRC meeting held on 27th to 29th January, 2025, the Committee considered the court matter and decided to file the application for vacating of stay against the interim order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat vide Order No. SCA 19764/2023 dated 08.11.2023 before the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat, Ahmedabad.

The Committee in this meeting considered the legal opinion given by the Legal Division, WRC on 20.06.2025, wherein recommended to file a Special Leave Petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court for vacating the stay dated 08.11.2023 along with an application for condonation of delay.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in reference to above legal opinion, SLP be filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court for vacating the stay dated 08.11.2023.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined

in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of final Show Cause Notice dated 17.01.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The University has not uploaded Not for profit Certificate issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (ii) The University has not uploaded Land Conversion Order and Mutation Certificate in respect of Khasra no. 81/1, 83/1, 89/3, 92/1, 92/2, 92/3, 97, 98, 95, 99, 181, 182,77, 80, 81/2, 81/3, 83/2, 83/3, 83/2, 83/3, 84, 100/1, 100/2 issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) in respect of Khasra no. 81/1,83/1,89/3,92/1,92/2,92/3,97,98,95,99,181,182,77,80,81/2,81/3,83/2, 83/3,84,100/1,100/2 except Khasra No. 81/2 & 81/3 issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The University has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (v) The University is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A., B.Sc., BCA, B.Com., BBA M.A., M.Com., M.Sc., Agriculture, Computer Science, Engineering, Law, Library Science, Management Studies, Media Studies, Pharmacy. The sufficiency of land area and built-up area of multidisciplinary courses and teacher education programmes i.e. B.Ed., B.Ed. (part time), M.Ed., B.A.B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed., Ph.D. course cannot be ascertained.
- (vi) The applicant University has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (vii) The University has uploaded BCC approved by the Secretary of Gram Panchayat for Kh. No. 81/2 81/3 only and not for other Kh. Nos. mentioned in the particulars and the University has not uploaded latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises. Further, the total land area and total built-up area does not match with total land area and total built-up area mentioned in application form.
- (viii) The University has uploaded list of teaching staff for the academic session 2025-26 duly approved and countersigned by the Registrar, Oriental University. However, the session 2025-26 has not yet started.
- (ix) The institution has uploaded bank statement indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff. However, it cannot be ascertained from the uploaded documents whether the institution is paying salary to its staff as per Central/State Government pay scales in accordance with the norms and standards of NCTE.
- (x) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

In view of the above, the application for transition to ITEP is rejected.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with Virtual Inspection Report dated 27.05.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Provisions for Barrier free Accessibility and facilities for Disabled are not available in the building. Site Plan does not show position of building(s) and the part of land earmarked for Teacher Education Courses Approved Plan of Third Floor as seen in virtual tour is not presented.
- (ii) Physical measurements cannot be taken in online meeting, sizes of rooms are accepted based on the approved maps presented by the Institute in Online Meeting. Area details in approved plans were not bearing the order of room numbers as mentioned hereby. Area details of third floor not available in approved maps presented by Institute.
- (iii) Completion Certificate dtd. 18-11-2022 by AEN, Nagar Nigam, Jaipur presented by Institute. Approved Plans and Safety Certificates do not include construction on third floor as visible in the front and rear view Ramps at entrance are not provided in Block A. No provision of Ramp or Lift in any building to reach the upper floors. Accessible Toilets not available at present but under construction as declared by Institute in online Meeting.
- (iv) Additional third floor as seen in front and rear view are not part of approved plans and the safety certificates presented by Institute. Most Labs were found to be poorly equipped, furniture was not adequate in class rooms, labs, library and multipurpose hall. Most parts of buildings were found to be under repair and renovation.
- (v) There is seating capacity for 50 persons so inadequate seating capacity.
- (vi) Professional Research Journal is not accepted.
- (vii) Seating capacity of Multipurpose Hall for 200 persons is not accepted and adequate seating not present.
- (viii) Education Encyclopedia is not available.
- (ix) Electronic Publications not available.
- (x) Digital or Online Resources not available.
- (xi) Science Stream Laboratories available but not fully equipped.
- (xii) Humanities Stream Laboratories available but not fully equipped.
- (xiii) Activity Cum Resource Center not available.
- (xiv) Common Room available but not well-equipped.
- (xv) Availability of adequate Furniture not available.
- (xvi) Repair and replacement of furniture and other equipment not available.
- (xvii) Availability of developed Kitchen Garden not available.
- (xviii) Facilities for co-curricular activities not available, limited facilities and activity area is available.
- (xix) The institution needs to improve infrastructural facilities accordingly, as labs, i.e., language, ICT, and psychology, need improvement accordingly.

- (xx) Students were not present and no interaction could take place.
- (xxi) Institute is not having facilities for divaangjan and also lack good teaching learning infrastructure.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with Virtual Inspection Report dated 16.06.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Building Plans are not prepared by Council of Architecture registered Architect. There is no seal and sign of the Architect.
- (ii) Electronic Publication not available.
- (iii) Digital or Online Resources not available.
- (iv) Humanities Stream Laboratories not available.
- (v) The multipurpose hall is not well-equipped
- (vi) ICT lab is just like a classroom
- (vii) The playground is like cultivated land
- (viii) The toilets are not sufficient number and good condition
- (ix) The library is not in good condition and up to date. The lab is not well equipped.
- (x) The institution applied for 2+2 units for B.Sc, B.Ed., and BA., B.Ed, but the infrastructure to accommodate the aforesaid students are not appropriate as
 - a) ICT lab has only 7 computers, which is not enough; it may be improved accordingly
 - b) Toilet facilities are not up to par, as the three-story building has limited toilet facilities available only on the ground floor. Toilets must be established at each and every floor of the building...
 - c) Spatially abled students are not able to go to the first and second floors, as there is no lift or ramp. Besides, toilets for especially abled students are not available except on the ground floor, and that is also not up to par.
 - d) Psychology lab must be established in a separate room? Classroom furniture is old and traditional.
 - e) In the library, no e-resources were found, and research-up-to-date journals and electronic publications are not available.
- (xi) College is not ready to accommodate 2+2 units for BSc, B.Ed., BA, and B.Ed.; therefore, applications may be approved only after getting appropriate instructional and infrastructural facilities available accordingly.
 - a) Building Plans are not prepared by Council of Architecture registered Architect. There is no seal and sign of the Architect.
 - b) There is no provision of Lift or Ramp for upper floors.
 - c) There is no Toilet for physical handicap persons

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution had not uploaded the reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 21.04.2025 on the following grounds within the stipulated time and deficiencies are still persisting:

- (i) The name of the institution "SAINT SOLDIER MAHILA MAHAVIDYALAYA" mentioned in the application and recognition order of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. whereas "St. SOLDIER MAHILA MAHAVIDYALAYA" mentioned in the university letter of affiliation with regard to Multi-disciplinary Programmes uploaded by the institution. Both the names are different. Therefore, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time, the application of the institution does not fall in the category of Multi-disciplinary institution.
- (ii) In the uploaded document of Mutation Certificate of Land, Khasra Nos. mentioned do not match with the Building Plan. The institution is required to upload Mutation Certificate of Land mentioning all Khasra Nos. as per online transition application issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (iii) Total built-up area mentioned in affidavit does not match with total built-up area mentioned in the Building Plan for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (iv) Khasra Nos. mentioned in the application do not match with land possession certificate dated 08.01.2025. In the uploaded Affidavit, land is on ownership basis whereas uploaded land document does not show whether the same is on ownership basis or lease basis. The institution is required to upload the proper documents related to land.
- (v) The institution is required to upload latest affiliation letter for B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. course.
- (vi) The institution is required to upload Non-Encumbrance Certificate mentioning complete details of land issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (vii) The institution is required to upload latest essential details regarding students admitted along with list of students admitted for 4 year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course (year-wise I,II,III,IV)approved by Registrar of concerned University.
- (viii) The institution has uploaded Photograph of college building having the name of the applicant institution. The institution is required to submit geotag photographs of college building with different angles clearly indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
- (ix) The institution is required to submit geotag photographs of college building in respect of different courses running in the premises with different angles clearly indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
- (x) The institution is required to upload Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authorityissued by Competent Government Authority.

- (xi) As per photograph of Multipurpose Hall uploaded on the portal, the same does not look to be as per NCTE Norms and Regulations. The institution is required to mention size of multipurpose hall in Building Plan and submit geotag photographs of the Multipurpose Hall with different angles clearly indicating the longitude and latitude with date of photograph.
- (xii) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (xiii) The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.

In view of the above, the application for transition to ITEP is rejected.

Show Cause Notice u/S 17 vide letter F.No. NCTE/WRC/APW00680/223211 (B.ED.)/APW07423/225140 (M.ED.)/APW06098/222320 (D.EL.ED.)/368th MEETING/2022/221396 to 221401 dated 27.12.2022 was issued to the institution for compliance of revised recognition order issued for two years duration B.Ed. course and two years duration M.Ed. course. The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Committee in its 410th Meeting held on 30th – 31th December 2024 considered the complaint against the institution received through Commissionerate, College Education, Govt. of Rajasthan, Block- 4, RKS Sankul, JLN Road, Jaipur- 302015, Rajasthan and decided for conducting inspection u/S 13 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, the institution was informed vide various E.mail dated 02.05.2025, 06.05.2025 and 02.06.2025 to provide requisite institutional data and complete information required to fill in the online Inspection Portal of NCTE in the prescribed format as a part of process by NCTE. In response, the institution has submitted reply through E.mail dated 05.05.2025, 12.05.2025, 03.06.2025 and 16.06.2025, without attaching relevant openable PDF Documents at the appropriate place of institutional data, but submitted incomplete information in respect of all points mentioned in ETEI replica VT format required to be filled by institution, resulting which process of inspection could not be initiated by NCTE.

The Committee noted that despite several opportunities given to the institution to provide inspection related institutional data/ information, the institution had failed to provide the requisite document/information for which complete information could not be filled by the office of WRC and matter still pending.

The Committee decided that the last opportunity be given to the institution to submit compliance regarding fulfillment of above shortfalls.

Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution for providing

appropriate reply with complete information together with attaching all openable PDF documents digitally at the designated place of ETEI Replica VT within 15 days from the issue of this letter failing which appropriate decision in the light of provisions contained in NCTE Act, Norms and Regulation shall be taken against the institution.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Committee considered the representation vide letter Ref.No.1415/M/2024-2025 dated 20.04.2025 received in WRC, NCTE on 02.05.2025 along with a copy of order dated 21.02.2025 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 1685/2025 by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jodhpur in connection with shifting of premises application of the institution enclosing copies of certain documents therein.

The Committee noted that as stated in the above representation, since the year 2010, the institution *suo motu* has shifted the institution (Mata Gujari Khalsa College of Education) recognized for B.Ed. course from its existing address: Guru Singh Sabha, Sri Ganganagar, Rajasthan where it was granted recognition to its proposed new premises: Chak 9Z, Sri Ganganagar, Rajasthan-335001 without prior approval of NCTE, which is in violation of the provisions of NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.

The institution did not submit compliance report regarding fulfillment of laid down conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order dated 27.04.2015 pertaining to its existing premises wherein recognition for B.Ed. course was initially granted by NCTE.

On going through the case in details, the Committee noted that the institution is required to submit compliance report regarding fulfillment of conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order on the following within 15 days from the date of issuance of letter:

- (i) The institution is required to submit latest original certified copy Land Documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning name of the institution/society, all Khasra Nos./Plot No./Survey No., land area after conversion to use the land from agriculture to educational purpose issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (v) The institution is required to submit latest original certified Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating name of institution/society, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary

- programmes, if any.
- (vi) The institution is required to submit latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (vii) The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) The institution is required to submit latest Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan.
- (ix) The institution is required to submit latest Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- (x) The institution is required to submit latest/ current faculty list approved & signed on each page by concerned affiliating body in original for all recognized courses separately with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection/appointment, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GoI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized representative of management along with copy of approval letter of affiliating body.
- (xi) Notarized original affidavit on Rs.100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper by individual selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- (xii) The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.
- (xiii) The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts issued by Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment Fund (Rs.5.00 lakh) & Reserve Fund (Rs.7.00 lakh) in the joint operation mode with Regional Director, WRC, NCTE and the Management along with duly filled Bank Form "A" in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 for each recognized teacher education course separately.
