At the outset **Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Regional Director**, and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members, apprised about the work done by the SRC along with the directions received from NCTE Hqrs. from time to time.

	<b>File No.APSO8882, Course – B.Ed.- AI</b>
	The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, directions of the Hon'ble Court, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The SRC in its 405<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> December 2021 considered the matter of the institution and decided to issue continuation order for B.Ed., Programme with one basic unit and B.Ed., (Additional Intake) was withdrawn by SRC vide order dated 21<sup>st</sup> December 2021, on the following grounds:-<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ The institution submitted faculty list which is sufficient for 1 unit of B.Ed., programme. The institution failed to submit faculty list for 2<sup>nd</sup> Unit of B.Ed., B.Ed., (Additional Intake) and M.Ed., Programme as per NCTE Regulations 2014.</li><li>○ The institution did not submit form A issued by the bank regarding maintenance of FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve Fund for M.Ed., programme.</li><li>○ The institution did not submit proof of disbursement of salary to faculty &amp; non-teaching staff through bank account as required under clause 10 (2) of NCTE Regulations 2014.</li></ul></li><li>• The institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 12/07/2022 confirmed the withdrawal order of SRC.</li><li>• The institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Tamilnadu (Madurai</li></ul>



**Bench) and the Hon'ble Court vide order in W.M.P (MD) Nos 4894 & 4878 of 2024 has directed as under:-**

*The second respondent will issue notice to the petitioner and the petitioner shall place all the relevant materials for the consideration of the second respondent. The second respondent is at liberty to verify the correctness of the particulars to be furnished by the petitioner herein and pass appropriate order. This shall be done as expeditiously as possible.*

- **The matter was considered by SRC in its 434<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2024 wherein the SRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution on certain grounds. Accordingly, SCN was issued to the institution on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024.**
- **The reply of the institution was considered by SRC in its 444<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> October 2024 wherein the SRC decided as under:-**

*After considering the documents submitted by the Institution the committee observed that the staff members list provided by the institution does not fulfil the mandatory eligibility requirements laid down by NCTE (Regulations Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014. It is observed that the following members do not fulfil the eligibility:*

1. Ms. M Rethi
2. Mrs. D Thilagavathi
3. Mrs. L Brigit
4. Mrs. M Meenakshi
5. Mrs. A Arockia Gracy

**Therefore, the Committee has decided to issue continuation of recognition order for 1 Unit (50 Students) of B.Ed., programme and 1 Unit (50 Students) for M.Ed., Programme w.e.f. the academic year 2025-2026.**

- **Instead of preferring an Appeal against the above decision of SRC, the institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Tamil Nadu (Madurai Bench) wherein the Hon'ble Court in W.P. (MD) No. 13005/2025 has directed as under:-**

*In the light of the above observations, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representations dated 25.03.2025 and 15.04.2025, on its own merits and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after giving due opportunity to the petitioner, as well as all other persons, who may be interested in the subject matter, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. It is also made clear that this Court has not expressed any of its views with regard to the merits of the matter and that it is open to the second respondent to consider the same on its own merits.*

- **As per the directions of the Hon'ble Court, a letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025 was sent to the institution if it wants to submit any other supporting document, they can file it within 10 days of the receipt of the letter.**
- **Accordingly, the institution vide letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> June 2025 has submitted the representation. As per the representation, the following has been observed by SRC :-**
- **The institution has submitted the staff list approved by the affiliating body on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025.**

- The institute submitted a copy of letter dated 20.07.2019 issued by the Registrar, Gulbarga University whereby only 14 Faculty is approved which is not sufficient for running B.Ed. programme with 2 units as per NCTE Regulations.

The institution instead of preferring an appeal against the above has not approached the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, wherein the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 30.01.2025 has directed the following:-

*"...9. The impugned order withdrawing the recognition of the petitioner is upheld. However, respondent No. 1 is directed to reconsider the representations of the petitioners dated 05.02.2022 and 27.05.2022.*

*10. In order to enable the respondent No. 1 to consider the representation, the petitioners are directed to furnish a fresh set of the representations alongwith all the accompanying documents to respondent No. 1 within a period of one month from today.*

*The respondent No. 1 shall consider the same and dispose of the representations in accordance with law within a period of two months thereafter."*

The matter was considered by SRC wherein the SRC after considering the original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, representation dated 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 received from the institution and noted the following:-

- The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide order dated 29<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- Against the above withdrawal order, the institution should have preferred an appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, which is a remedy available with the institution.
- The representation of the institution dated 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 submitted in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Court was considered and the SRC observed the following:-
  - a. The institution has submitted the list of 10 teaching staff approved by Gulbarga University, Gulbarga, as against the requirement of 1+15 as per NCTE Regulations. From the above list, except Principal and two staff, none of the remaining staff are qualified as per NCTE Regulations 2014.
- The institution is non-existent for a period of four years. It is not clear whether the institution is having the requisite infrastructure / instructional facilities as per the provisions / Regulations of State Government / University / NCTE.
- From the above, it is clear that the institution was lacking with regard to infrastructural and instructional facilities as provided in the NCTE Regulations for the B.Ed. programme and the withdrawal order was rightly issued by SRC.

Keeping in view the above facts, the SRC after thorough deliberation decided that the representation dated 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 submitted by the institution is devoid of merits and the withdrawal order issued by SRC vide dated 29<sup>th</sup> July 2021 stands affirmed.

The institution is at liberty to apply afresh to NCTE as and when the NCTE invites applications for Teacher Education Programme (s) through online portal.
