Decision of NRC

The online file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Rules, NCTE Regulations 2014, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time along with the order passed by the Appellate Authority were placed before the Northern Regional Committee. As per the decision of the NRC during its 432nd meeting, the institution's application was refused through an order dated 20/01/2025 based on the following reasons:

- The institution has submitted a NAAC certificate with a Grade of "B," which is valid until 28.02.2026, earning 4 points in this regard.
- The institution has been offering multidisciplinary courses since 19.12.2024, thus securing 1 point for this aspect.
- The institution has provided the recognition order for its B.Ed. program, which is acknowledged by the NCTE, resulting in an additional 2 points.
- According to the data submitted by the institution, the University has only accumulated 7 points. Given that a minimum of 10 points is necessary according to the shortlisting criteria for processing ITEP applications for the 2025-2026 session, the University's application is therefore ineligible to apply for the 4th phase of ITEP as per the Public Notice F. No. NCTE-Reg1012/1/2024-Reg.Sec-HQ dated 22.04.2024 issued by NCTE (HQ).

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- The institution preferred to file an appeal under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the refusal order dated 20/01/2025. Subsequently, the Appellate Authority issued an order on 12/03/2025, remanding the case back to the NRC. The Committee reviewed the Appeal Order dated 12/03/2025 and, upon examining the application, found it deficient for the following reasons:
- The institution claims to be a multidisciplinary institution for over 30 years; however, it has not provided any supporting evidence.
- The institution did not submit the processing fee, arguing that it is a Government College. It must provide proof that the proposed course will receive government funding.
- The institution failed to upload the NOC issued by the Affiliating University for the proposed ITEP.
- The institution has not provided an authorization letter on non-judicial stamp paper.
- The institution has not uploaded the "not-for-profit" certificate from the relevant Government Authority.
- The institution has not submitted the exemption Certificate (12A) from the Income Tax Department.
- The institution has not detailed the members of the society.
- The institution has not uploaded the revised recognition order for the B.Ed. course.
- The institution has not provided an Affidavit on Rs. 100 non-judicial stamp paper in the required format concerning land and built-up area.
- The institution must upload the latest certified copy of registered land documents for khasra no.1360-1380 from the Revenue Department.
- The institution has not uploaded the mutation certificate for khasra no.1360-1380 from the Revenue Department.
- The institution has not submitted the Land Use Certificate (CLU) confirming that the land is designated for educational purposes for khasra no.1360-1380 from the Revenue Department.
- The institution has not uploaded the Non-Encumbrance Certificate for khasra no.1360-1380 issued by the Revenue Department.
- The institution has uploaded building plan, however, the same is neither approved by the Competent Government Authority and clearly legible. The institution is

As per the decision of NRC in its 439th meeting held on 5th & 6th May 2025, Show Cause Notice after VT was issued to the University on 24/05/2025 on the following grounds:

- The University (State University) is housed temporarily in a Government School allotted by the State Government.
- · The books and journals are not recorded in the accession register.

The institution has submitted the reply of SCN after VT on 9/6/2025.

The Committee reviewed and deliberated upon the institution's response and acknowledged that the University is currently operating from a transit campus located at DOE, P-625 & 745, Outram Lane, New Delhi. Additionally, the Delhi Development Authority has allocated land to the University at Narela. The University has requested permission to continue operating from this transit campus until their permanent campus at Narela is established.

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In light of this, the Committee decided to forward the case of the Delhi Teachers University (State University) to NCTE (HQ) to seek their opinion under the subregulation (4) of Regulation 8 of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Amendment Regulations 2017, which was notified on 28.04.2017.

The Original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

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- The institution was recognized for conducting D.P.Ed. course vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-6586/288th Meeting/2018/196724-29 dated 13/09/2018.
- The institution was also recognized for conducting B.P.Ed. Programme (2-year) vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/PB-576/149 Meeting/2009/11043-11049 dated 06/10/2009 with an annual intake of 50 students followed by Revised Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/PB-576/2015/ 99553 57 dated 15.05.2017 with an annual intake of 50 students.
- The institution was also recognized for conducting B.P.Ed. (4-year Integrated)
 Programme vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/PB- Khalsa College of Physical
 Education/289th Meeting /2018 dated 14.12.2018 with an annual intake of 50
 students.
- The institution had submitted an application dated 27.05.2020 received in the office of NRC on 14.07.2020 for shifting of premises from Vill & Post- Heir, Tehsil & Distt- Amritsar- 143002, Punjab to G.T Road Amritsar, Punjab.
- The institution filed Writ Petition No. 12912/2023 titled as "Khalsa College of Physical Education vs N.C.T.E." seeking directions for NRC to decide the shifting application of the institution.

As per decision of NRC in its 439th Meeting held on 05th and 06th May, 2025 the Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 02/06/2025 on the following grounds:

- The institution is required to submit NOC from the affiliating body for shifting of premises and the NOC for change of affiliating body from Guru Nanak Dev University to the Maharaja Bhupinder Singh Sports University along with translated notarized English version.
- The institution is required to submit a certified copy of the registered land documents issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit the Mutation Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- CLU submitted is of another College, but the Khasra No. 220 matches with the College of Physical Education. Hence, the institution is required to submit the Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority mentioning the land details i.e. khasra nos./ plot nos. and total area of land.
- The NEC submitted by the institution is for the period from 01.01.2004 to 03.06.2020. 
