ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, Sundaram College of Education for Women, Plot No.-4473, Vill.-Kusumgram, P.O.-Kusumgram, Tehsil/Taluka-Monteswar, Town/City-Burdwan, Dist.-Bardhaman, West Bengal-713422 was granted recognition for conducting D.El.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide order No. ERC/7-182.6.11/NCTE/ERCAPP1593/D.El.Ed./2012/30724 dated 03.03.2015 from the academic session 2017-2018.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the Show cause notice under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 was issued on 12.08.2022 as per decision of 306th meeting of ERC held on 12th to 13th July, 2022 to the all institutions which have not filed PAR on the ground that the institution has breached the condition of recognition as per the provision of Clause 8(12) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and also clause 7(14)(i) of NCTE, Regulations, 2014 which is related to uploading information on the website, if the web site of the institution is not working.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was again placed before 311th meeting of ERC held on 11th Oct, 2022, and the case of the institutions which had not filled up the PAR was considered by the ERC in its 306th meeting held 12th & 13th July, 2022 and as per decision of the Committee, the Show cause notice under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 was issued on the ground that the institution has breached the condition of recognition as per the provision of clause 8(12) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and also Clause 7(14)(i) of NCTE, Regulations, 2014 which is related to uploading information on the website, if the web site of the institution is not working. The Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued before withdrawal of recognition under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice. As per decision of ERC-NCTE, SCN was issued to the applicant institution on 28.10.2022.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the matter was considered in 313th (virtual) meeting by ERC and the Committee observed that:

- *"As per provision contained in Section 12 (j) & (k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution was asked to fill up the Performance Appraisal report (PAR) for the academic session 2020-21, however, the institution has not filled up the same.*
- *Therefore, as per decision taken by ERC in its 306th meeting held on 12th to 13th July, 2022, Show Cause Notice under Section 17 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993 was issued to the institution for not filing PAR on the ground that the institution has breached the condition of recognition as per the provision of clause 8 (12) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and also clause 7 (14) of NCTE, Regulations, 2014 which is related to uploading information on the website, if the web site of the institution is not working.*

- Further, as per decision taken by ERC in its 311th meeting held on 11th October, 2022, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution for not submitting the reply of Show Cause Notice issued to it.
- The Committee further noted that the institution has not submitted the reply of Final Show Cause Notice.

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition for D.El.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to the institution viz. **Sundaram College of Education For Women Plot No.-4473, Vill.-Kusumgram, P.O.-Kusumgram, Tehsil/Taluka-Monteswar, Town/City-Burdwan, Dist.-Bardhaman, West Bengal-713422** vide order No. ERC/7-182.6.11/NCTE/ERCAPP1593/D.El.Ed./2012/30724 dated 03.03.2015 for running D.El.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.


6. FURTHER, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal Under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
