## Order

WHEREAS Govt. Women's Training College, Gautam Budha Marg, Bariyatu Road, Ranchi, Jharkhand–834009 (Code No. APE00101) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 20.06.2002 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2002-2003 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The institution shall appoint and function with Principal and 07 teaching staff and supporting staff possessing the qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms before the commencement of academic session 2002-2003 in the salary structure prescribed by the Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
- (ii) The institution shall ensure laboratories, educational journals, library and other instructional infrastructure by 30th September 2002 as per the NCTE norms.
- (iii) The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government.
- (iv) Tution fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
- (v) Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organized as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University/examining body.
- (vi) Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
- (vii) The institution shall continue to fulfill the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Performance Appraisal Report within 45 days of the last examination/academic session every year. The Performance Appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 7 above.
- 2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda Vs Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqrs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-46/2014/NCTE/Insp./A86397 dated 30.04.2014 with the following observations:-
- (i) In spite of being a Government institution with a standing of more than 30 years, the institution is very deficient, especially in respect of infrastructural and instructional facilities and also in respect of human resources. The shifting of the institution to the newly constructed building may make up deficiencies in respect of infrastructural facilities. The State Government needs to move fast to make up the deficiencies in respect of human resources and instructional facilities.

- 3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 09.06.2014 in response to deficiency letter dated 30.04.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172nd Meeting held on 17th June 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26595 dated 30.06.2014 on the following grounds:-
  - (i) The institution is functioning in the premises of the Government High School building.
  - (ii) There is no multipurpose hall.
  - (iii) No laboratory facilities are available.
  - (iv) Books in the Library are only 853 which is less than the required 3000.
  - (v) The ICT resource Centre and Psychology resource centre are not existent.
  - (vi) The Art & Craft Resource Center and Physical Education Resource Centre have not been set up.
  - (vii) The appointed faculty members are not qualified as per norms.
  - (viii) Qualified librarian, Lecturers for Physical Education and Art & Craft have not been appointed.
- 4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 15.07.2014 in response to show cause notice dated 30.06.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 174<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26926 dated 13.08.2014 on the following grounds:-
  - (i) The institution is functioning in the premises of the Government High School building which is against the rules.
  - (ii) There is no multipurpose hall,
  - (iii) Laboratories are not available in the institution. The ICT Resource Centre, Psychology resource centre, Art & Craft Resource Center and Physical Education Resource Centre have not been set up.
  - (iv) Books in the library are only 853 which is less than the required 3000.
  - (v) The teaching faculty is not qualified as per NCTE norms as the appointed faculty members are the officers of State Education Service and most of them are M.A. & B.Ed.
  - (vi) Qualified librarian, Part-time lecturers for Physical Education and Art & Craft have not been appointed.
- 5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 03.09.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 13.08.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 176th Meeting held on 09.10.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hars, as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-
  - (i) The institution is functioning in the premises of the Government High School building which is against the rules.
  - (ii) There is no multipurpose hall,
  - (iii) Laboratories are not available in the institution. The ICT Resource Centre, Psychology resource centre, Art & Craft Resource Center and Physical Education Resource Centre have not been set up.

- (iv) Books in the library are only 853 which is less than the required 3000.
- (v) The teaching faculty is not qualified as per NCTE norms as the appointed faculty members are the officers of State Education Service and most of them are M.A & B.Ed.
- (vi) Qualified librarian, Part-time lecturers for Physical Education and Art & Craft have not been appointed.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

- 6. NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to Govt. Women's Training College, Gautam Budha Marg, Bariyatu Road, Ranchi, Jharkhand–834009 (Code No. APE00101) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.
- 7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available at NCTE's website <a href="https://www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days of the issue of the order.
