WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition was granted to ASP College of Education, Plot No. 755/3031, 755/3032, Street/Road- Kakdwip Gangadharpur, Vill/Po.-Gangadharpur, Tehsil/Taluka- Gangadharpur, Town/City- Kakdwip, Dist- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal- 743347 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 Students *vide* Order No. ER-213.6(i).89/ERCAPP4253/B/Ed./2016/46039 dated 02.05.2016 from the academic session 2016-17 and another additional of 50 Students (existing 50 intake + additional 50 intake), thus making the total intake of 100 Students *vide* order No. ER-252.6.47(Part-3)/ID No.-9505/B.Ed. (Addl. Intake) dated 03.03.2018 from the academic session 2018-2019, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.


2. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter No. NCTE-CDN016(13)/18/2018-CDN-HQ dated 02.08.2018 was received from NCTE HQ. In compliance of the said letter, the matter was placed before 284th meeting of ERC-NCTE held on 17-18 September, 2020 and the Committee decided to issue the show cause notice to the institutions which have been recognized without NET qualified teachers. Accordingly, first SCN was issued to the institution on dated 30.09.2020. Reply dated 15.10.2020 & 17.11.2020 received on 20.10.2020 & 23.11.2020.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 303rd (Virtual) meeting held on 24th March, 2022 and the committee decided to issue final Show Cause Notice under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to all ninety seven (97 TEIs). Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dated 09.04.2022. No reply received from the institution in response to Final SCN dated 09.04.2022.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC in its 326th (virtual) meeting held on 23rd May, 2023 and the Committee observed that:

- *The institution has not submitted the reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 09.04.2022 issued to it.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to ASP College of Education, Plot No. 755/3031, 755/3032, Street/Road- Kakdwip Gangadharpur, Vill/Po.-Gangadharpur, Tehsil/Taluka- Gangadharpur, Town/City- Kakdwip, Dist- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal- 743347 for running B.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the end of academic session next following the date communication of withdrawal order.

6. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing recognition under sub-section (1), or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government”.

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 in the “Online mode” available on NCTE’s website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
