ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Kamarsa Educational and Welfare Trust, Khasara No. 223, Plot NO- 12, Vill- Subuddhichak, PO- Marh-Maheshpur, Tehsil- Chandrakona, Town/City- Khirpai, Dist- Midnapore, West Bengal-721232 has applied for grant of recognition to Kamarsha Teachers Training College, Khasara No. 223, Plot NO- 12, Vill- Subuddhichak, PO- Marh-Maheshpur, Tehsil- Chandrakona, Town/City- Khirpai, Dist- Midnapore, West Bengal-721232 was granted recognition for conducting D.El.Ed. (Course) with an intake of 50 from the academic session 2016-17 vide order No. ER-210.6.46/ERCAPP3390 /D.El.Ed./2016/45718 dated 27.04.2016

2. **AND WHEREAS**, A complaint letter dated 16.09.2016 received against the institution. The matter was placed before the ERC in its 282nd Meeting held on 8th – 9th July, 2020 and ERC decided to issued Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, as per above decision of ERC, show cause notice was issued to the applicant institution on 13th August, 2020. The institution has submitted reply letter dated 30.09.2020 received in the office 05.10.2020, the original file of the institution along with other related documents, in light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by ERC in its 303rd (Virtual) meeting held on 24th March, 2022, and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, as per above decision of ERC, Final Show Cause Notice issued to the institution on 05.04.2022, the institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice which was received on 05.05.2022. The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and reply in response to show cause notice were carefully considered by ERC in its 306th (Virtual) meeting held on 12th – 13th July, 2022 and Committee made following observations:

As per the decision of ERC taken in its 282nd Meeting, the First Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE, Act, 1993 was issued to the institution on 13.08.2020. The reply of SCN was considered by ERC in its 303rd meeting and as per the decision of ERC the final SCN was issued to the institution on 05.04.2022. The institution has submitted its reply dated 30.04.2022; the ERC has examined the same and found the institution deficient on the following points:

1. The institution has appointed teaching faculty of physical education namely Sh. Sanjay Ghosh which is not qualified as he is not M.P.Ed.
2. The institution has not submitted requisite documents/ certificate/ testimonials in respect of teaching faculty to verify their qualification as per the Norms prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, ERC decided that the recognition for D.El.Ed. Course be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 22.07.2022.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE Hqrs against withdrawal order dated 22.07.2022. The Appellate Authority has passed an order vide its order No. 89-214/E-265078/2022 Appeal/9th Meeting, 2022/APPLERC202214440/115540 dated 30.11.2022. The operative part of order as under:-

"...In view of the afore-mentioned extracts of the court orders, the impugned withdrawal order dated 22.07.2022 is set-aside and the Appellate Committee has decided to remand back the case to ERC for revisiting the matter.

Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to remand back the case to ERC with a direction to consider specific and pointed replies to the grounds of withdrawal to be submitted to the ERC by the appellant, duly supported by documents, with originals thereof, wherever necessary, within 15 days of receipt of orders on the appeal and take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014. The appellant is directed to forward to the ERC specific replies mentioned above within the timeframe set above".

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the ERC in its 321st (Virtual) meeting of the ERC held on 21st February, 2023 and the committee decided as under:-

The original file of the institution alongwith Appeal Order No.89-214/E-265078/2022 Appeal/9th Meeting, 2022/APPLERC202214440/115540 dated 30.11.2022, other related documents submitted by the institution, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC.

- The Committee noted that the withdrawal order 22.07.2022 has already been set aside by the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 30.11.2022 and remanded back to ERC for consideration, therefore, ERC decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running D.El.Ed. programme is hereby restored. Order be issued accordingly.*

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, In terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to Kamarsha Teachers Training College, Khasara No. 223, Plot NO- 12, Vill- Subuddhichak, PO- Marh-Maheshpur, Tehsil- Chandrakona, Town/City- Khirpai, Dist- Midnapore, West Bengal- 721232 vide order No. ER-210.6.46/ERCAPP3390 /D.El.Ed./2016/45718 dated 27.04.2016 for D.El.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) is hereby restored.
