Sub:- Decision of 306th meeting held from 12th to 13th July, 2022.

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Govt. Teachers Training College, Ranchi, Jharkhand-834001 (Code No.JH-S/N-6/2001) was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 (One Basic Unit) vide order No. ERC/7-25/2002/1844 dated 20.06.2002 for B.Ed. course from academic session 2002-2003 followed by revised recognition order for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. ERC/NCTE/JH-/N-6/2001/B.Ed. (Revised Order)/2015/32743 dated 31.05.2015.

- 2. In the ERC in its 275thmeeting held on 275th(Part-1) ERC Meeting held on 26thJuly 2019 decided that recognition granted to B.Ed. course be withdrawn under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2020-2021 and as per decision of committee, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 28.08.2019.
- 3. The institution preferred an appeal before the council (NCTE) under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 against the withdrawal order dated 28.03.2019 passed by ERC. The Appellate Authority vide its Order No.F.No.89-62/E-244430/2022 Appeal/4th Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202114101/111217 dated 26.05.2022 concluded to remand back the case to ERC.
- 4. In compliance of Appeal order dated 26.05.2022, the institution has submitted documents vide letter dated 31.05.2022 received in this office on 07.06.2022. The ERC in its 306th(Virtual) meeting held on 12th and 13th July, 2022 considered the same and the original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and direction of appellate authority and the Committee made following observations:

The recognition was withdrawn by the ERC vide order dated 28/08/2019, the institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 before the Council against the withdrawal order dated 28/08/2019 passed by ERC. The Appeal Committee passed an order dated 26/05/2022 and remanded the matter back to ERC with direction to consider the documents submitted by the appellant and take further necessary action as per NCTE Regulations, 2014. The appeal committee in its above order noted that the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 15/12/2020 passed in W.P. (C) No.4382/2021 has observed as follows:

"Although the Appellate Committee of the NCTE would be well advised to expressly quash the original order of the concerned Regional Committee while remanding the matter, the position in law is that the order automatically stands quashed. The institution is, therefore, entitled to the benefits of recognition until a fresh withdrawal order is passed"

Keeping in view of above, the ERC decided that the withdrawal order dated 28/08/2019 stands quashed, and the institution is entitled for the benefits of recognition until a fresh withdrawal order is passed.

- 5. The ERC further decided that SCN be issued U/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution on following points:-
 - Two lecturers of Perspective in Education for teaching History at Sl.No.1 (Dulal Chandra Mahato) & Sl.No.2 (Hirkoxess) and one lecturer in Curriculum and Pedagogic courses for teaching English at Sl.No.8 (Chanchala Kumari Panday) appointed after NCTE Gazette Notification dated 09.06.2017 do not possess NET/Ph.D. qualification. Hence, they are not qualified as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended time to time.
- 6. In terms of above decision of ERC, the withdrawal order dated 28.08.2019 is hereby quashed and the institution is entitled for the benefits of recognition until a fresh withdrawal order is passed.

7. The Show cause notice U/s 17 of NCTE as decided above is being issued separately.
