ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition was granted to **Mahant Darshan Das Mahila College, Vill:- Mithanpura, Street / Road:- Club Road, Taluka/Mandal:- Mushahari, Town/City:- Mithanpura, Dist:-Muzaffarpur, Bihar-842002** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration *vide* Order No. F.No.ERC/250.6.41/B.Ed./2018/App. Code No. ERCAPP201646001 Appl. ID. No. 10082/56165 dated 26.02.2018 from the academic session 2018-2019, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the recognition of the institution was withdrawn by ERC-NCTE on 08.06.2023. The institution preferred appeal before NCTE Appellate Authority against the Withdrawal Order dated 08.06.2023 and NCTE Appellate Authority decided that the instant Appeal deserves to be rejected and therefore, the impugned Withdrawal Order dated 08.06.2023 issued by the ERC is confirmed.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Patna in W.P. (C) No. 5195/2022 against the Appeal Order dated 27.02.2024 passed by the NCTE Appellate Authority and the Withdrawal Order dated 08.06.2023 passed by the ERC, NCTE.

4. AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court of Patna has passed an order dated 30.01.2025 that *the submission made in paragraph no. 12 of the supplementary affidavit, the present writ application stands disposed of as having become infructuous*. The Hon'ble High court has not given any direction to NCTE for further action

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter mentioned Order dated 30.01.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Patna was considered by ERC in its 364th meeting held on 30 April 2025 and the committee decided as under:

The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, order of Appellate Authority, court order passed by Hon'ble High Court, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were considered and noted by ERC:-

- 1. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by ERC-NCTE on 08.06.2023.*
- 2. The institution preferred appeal before NCTE Appellate Authority against the Withdrawal Order dated 08.06.2023 and NCTE Appellate Authority decided that the instant Appeal deserves to be rejected and therefore, the impugned Withdrawal Order dated 08.06.2023 issued by the ERC is confirmed.*
- 3. The institution has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Patna in W.P. (C) No. 5195/2022 against the Appeal Order dated 27.02.2024 passed by the NCTE Appellate Authority and the Withdrawal Order dated 08.06.2023 passed by the ERC, NCTE.*

4. *The Hon'ble High Court of Patna has passed an order dated 30.01.2025 that the submission made in paragraph no. 12 of the supplementary affidavit, the present writ application stands disposed of as having become infructuous. The Hon'ble High court has not given any direction to NCTE for further action.*

In view of above, the Committee has decided that no action is required. The institution can file an appeal before Appellate Authority of NCTE.

6. **Accordingly**, a letter dated 03.06.2025 was issued to the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the Delhi High Court while deciding the matter has allowed the W.P. (C) No. 9840/2024 of the petitioner and quashed the impugned order dated 08.06.2023 passed by ERC and the order 27.02.2024 passed by the Appellate Committee. Operative part of the order dated 24.09.2025 is as under:

"5. Consequently, respondent no.3/ERC is directed to restore the recognition of petitioner qua 50 seats (one basic unit) within a period of 10 days. The respondents are directed to communicate to the affiliating university, i.e., Bahasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar Bihar University as well as the State Government within a period of one week thereafter. The respondents are further directed to update the status of petitioner on their website within a period of one week.

6. Insofar as the remaining 50 seats are concerned, the following directions are passed:

(i) The NCTE is directed to carry out fresh inspection in terms of Section 13 of the NCTE Act and inform the petitioner institution about recommendations, if any, on the basis of such inspection;

(ii) In the event any deficiencies are pointed out in the recommendations, NCTE will grant reasonable time to the petitioner institution to rectify the same; and

(iii) If no deficiencies are recommended, or in case deficiencies recommended by NCTE are rectified by petitioner institution during the time period granted to it, ERC will restore the recognition of petitioner institution for B.Ed. course (one basic units-50 seats), and consequently, NCTE shall communicate about the restoration order to the affiliating university of the petitioner institution, as well as, to the State Government. Further, NCTE will also do the needful with regard to updation of the status of petitioner institution on its website.

7. In view of above, petition stands disposed of."

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the aforesaid matter and the order dated 24.09.2025 was placed before 379th meeting of ERC held on 30.09.2025 and the committee decided as under:

"Decision of ERC:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, Delhi High Court's Order dated 24.09.2025, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:

1. *The recognition of the institution was granted for B.Ed. Course with 100 seats (i.e. two basic units). Subsequently, vide order dated 08.06.2023, the recognition was withdrawn on account of not having adequate number of faculties. The appeal preferred by institution against the said order was also dismissed by the Appellate Committee vide order dated 27.02.2024.*
2. *The institute filed a WP(C) no. 9840/2024 challenging the withdrawal order dated 08.06.2023 and appeal order order 27.02.2024. Accordingly, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed a Judgement dated 24.09.2025, operative part of the same is as below:*
3. *In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.*
4. *Accordingly, impugned order dated 08.06.2023 passed by ERC and the order 27.02.2024 passed by the Appellate Committee are quashed.*
5. *Consequently, respondent no.3/ERC is directed to restore the recognition of petitioner qua 50 seats (one basic unit) within a period of 10 days. The respondents are directed to communicate to the affiliating university, i.e., Bahasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar Bihar University as well as the State Government within a period of one week thereafter. The respondents are further directed to update the status of petitioner on their website within a period of one week.*
6. *Insofar as the remaining 50 seats are concerned, the following directions are passed:*
 - (i) *The NCTE is directed to carry out fresh inspection in terms of Section 13 of the NCTE Act and inform the petitioner institution about recommendations, if any, on the basis of such inspection;*
 - (ii) *In the event any deficiencies are pointed out in the recommendations, NCTE will grant reasonable time to the petitioner institution to rectify the same; and*
 - (iii) *If no deficiencies are recommended, or in case deficiencies recommended by NCTE are rectified by petitioner institution during the time period granted to it, ERC will restore the recognition of petitioner institution for B.Ed. course (one basic units- 50 seats), and consequently, NCTE shall communicate about the restoration order to the affiliating university of the petitioner institution, as well as, to the State Government. Further, NCTE will also do the needful with regard to updation of the status of petitioner institution on its website.*
7. *In view of above, petition stands disposed of.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided to restore the one unit of 50 seats and copy of the restoration order also be endorsed to affiliating university as well as the State Authority. IT Division be also requested to update the website accordingly. Insofar as the remaining 50 seats are concerned, NCTE-HQ be requested to carry out the inspection in terms of Section 13 of the NCTE act as directed by the Hon'ble High Court. After the receipt of the inspection report, the Committee will follow the instructions as ordered by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi."

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to **Mahant Darshan Das Mahila College, Vill:- Mithanpura, Street / Road:- Club Road, Taluka/Mandal:- Mushahari, Town/City:- Mithanpura, Dist:-Muzaffarpur, Bihar-842002** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration *vide* Order No. F.No.ERC/250.6.41/B.Ed./2018/Apl. Code No. ERCAPP201646001 Appl. ID. No. 10082/56165 dated 26.02.2018 is hereby restored for one unit (50 seats).

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the Official Gazette.
