
ORDER

In exercise of the authority vested under NCTE Act, the Eastern Regional Committee after considering the application of *College of Education, Christian Basti, Guwahati, Assam* for grant of recognition to the **B.Ed.** course of one year duration, has decided to accord **one year provisional recognition for the academic year 1999-2000 with intake of 60 (sixty) students** subject to removal of the following deficiencies:

1. Qualifications of teaching staff should be as per NCTE norms.
2. Instructional area, furniture, equipment and books and journals in library should be as per NCTE norms.
3. Laboratories and staff-quarters should be provided.

The institution is advised to send a compliance report in respect of qualifications of teaching staff and removal of other deficiencies to the Eastern Regional Committee by 31.12.1999.
