

WHEREAS The Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE, Bhubaneshwar (ERC) in its Order No. ERC/7-39(ER-39.4.3)/2003/3145 dated 11th November, 2003 withdrawing recognition for conducting B.Ed course in S.D.P. College of Teacher Education, Tihu, Nalbari, Assam on the grounds that (i) the curriculum transaction is not maintained as per NCTE norms, (ii) out of the total teachers appointed by the institution, four do not have P.G. Degree in Education and none of them have qualified NET/SLET, (iii) Science and Psychology laboratories have not been equipped, (iv) the education technology lab does not have computer and associated peripherals, (v) the infrastructure facilities are

AND WHEREAS, the Correspondent, S.D.P. College of Teacher Education, Tihu, Nalbari, Assam (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated the 16th February, 2004 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi, (herein after referred to as the council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

inadequate, (vi) the salary paid to the teaching staff is not as per the scale prescribed by the Central/State/UGC and (vii) the salary is not paid in cheque.

AND WHEREAS Mr. Kishore Kr. Talukdar, Secy, Governing Body and Mr. Pabinora Nath Das, Asstt Secy, Governing Body, S.D.P. College of Teacher Education, Assam presented the case of the appellant institution on the 24th May, 2004. In the appeal as well as during personal presentation the institution was not able to submit the documentary proof in regard to the removal of the deficiencies pointed out by Regional Committee. In the circumstances the Committee decided to give 15 days time to the appellant institution to submit replies to all the deficiencies, duly supported by authentic documentary evidence while withdrawing.

AND WHEREAS the appellant submitted the documents on 29-05-2004. On perusal by the Special Appeal Committee meeting on 27th July, 2004 the documents furnished by the institution regarding maintenance of Stock as well as the salary paid to the staff were found to be satisfactory.

AND WHEREAS, The Council after careful consideration of all aspect of the matter has come to the conclusion that the appeal of S.D.P. College of Teacher Education, Tihu, Assam deserved to be accepted and the Order of ERC reversed.

AND NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby reverses the Order of ERC, Bhubaneshwar appealed against.
