Order

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Dhemaji Post Graduate Training College, Dhemaji – 787 057, Assam had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration from the academic session 1997-98 with an annual intake of 125 (One hundred twenty five) students.

The institution was granted recognition upto end of the academic session 1997-98 for B.Ed. course with intake of 60 students vide order No. 2802 dt. 12.2.97 and the last recognition was granted to the institution from the academic year 2001-2002 with intake of 60 vide order No. 226 dt. January 24, 2001.

Subsequently, the recognition to the institution was withdrawn vide order No. 256 dt. January 30, 2003 and the institution preferred an appeal in the Hqrs. and appeal committee had remanded back this case to ERC vide order No. 32384 dt. 27th May, 2003. This order of appeal committee was placed before the Eastern Regional-Committee on 23.7.2003.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3.12 lakhs (equivalent to three months salary of teaching staff)
- iii) The institution has appointed the Principal, five regular and one ad-hoc lecturer for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the affiliating University, the copy of which was presented to appeal committee as mentioned in the their order dt. 27th May, 2003.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Dhemaji Post Graduate Training College, Dhemaji – 787 057, Assam for B.Ed. Course of one year duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an annual intake of 60 (Sixty) students subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a) That the institution will ensure that Principal and at least seven regular faculty members duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 60 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall


- be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- b) That the institution will submit a copy of the list of teaching staff duly approved by the competent authority of the University within one month,
- c) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
