Order

In exercise of the authority vested under NCTE Act, the Eastern Regional Committee after considering the application of **Diphu B.Ed. College, Diphu (Assam)** for grant of recognition to the **B.Ed.** course of one year duration, decided to accord one year conditional recognition for the academic year 2000-2001 with intake of 60 subject to removal of the following deficiencies:

- 1. Three teachers out of six are not qualified as per NCTE norms.
- Teachers are paid only Rs.3000/- per month against the recommendations of NCTE for UGC/State Govt. scales.
- 3. Classes should run for six hours during the regular day shift.
- 4. Furniture and other equipment should be procured as per NCTE norms.
- 5. Multipurpose lab. for computer, psychology and science practical equipped as per NCTE norms should be developed.
- 6. The institution should appoint librarian qualified as per NCTE norms.
- 7. The institution should increase books from 300 to (500) as per NCTE norms.
- 8. The institution should subscribe to educational journals in the library.
- 9. Supervised practice teaching should be conducted as per NCTE norms.
- 10. The institution should function for minimum of 200 days/1200 hours as per NCTE norms.
- 11. The institution should admit candidates possessing at least 45% marks in aggregate in graduation/post graduation examination.
- 12. The institution should maintain reserve fund and endowment as per NCTE norms.
- 13. The institution should obtain affiliation from the university and report to ERC.

The institution is advised to send a compliance report about removal of the above deficiencies to the Eastern Regional Committee by 31.8.2000. It may also be clarified whether any of the employees of the institution is a regular Govt. servant.
