Order

WHEREAS, Diphu B.Ed. College, Po-Diphu, Dist-Karbi Anglong, Assam-782460 had applied for grant of permission (code No. APE00452) for additional intake in B.Ed. Course of one year duration under Section 15(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar.

- 2. AND WHEREAS in its 84th meeting held on 22-23 February, 2008 the Eastern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, was satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and came to the conclusion that permission to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:
 - i. Possession certificate in favour of society has not been submitted.
 - ii. Legally valid land documents have not been submitted.
 - iii. Non encumbrance certificate has not been submitted.
 - iv. Approved building plan signed by the competent authority not submitted.
 - v. Details of Website as per regulations not launched.
- 3. AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Diphu B.Ed. College, Po-Diphu, Dist-Karbi Anglong, Assam-782460 (hereinafter referred to as the applicant), preferred an appeal dated 10.05.2008 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.
- 4. AND WHEREAS having considered the verbal submission by the representative of the institution the written representation, the original record of the case and V.T. Report, the Council decided to reverse the order of ERC. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted with direction to ERC to grant recognition to the institution immediately vide Hars Order No. F.No.-89-223/2008-Appeal/85549 dated 14.10.2008. A letter under Regulation 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2005 was not issued to the institution.
- 5. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to Diphu B.Ed. College, Po-Diphu, Dist-Karbi Anglong, Assam-782460 for conducting **B.Ed.** Course of **one year** duration with an **additional annual intake** of **60 students** thus making the total intake of 100 under clause 7(12) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2005 subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition/permission order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an officer of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The admission of students shall be done only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of academic year and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic year 2008-2009 failing which the recognition will be deemed to be for the next academic year i.e. 2009-2010.
- (iii) The letter of intent i.e. letter for conditional recognition under Regulations 7(9) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007 would be subject to the condition that the institution shall not have any right for recognition pertaining to any particular academic year and the discretion is left with NCTE.
- (iv) Formal order for recognition/permission will operate for 2008-2009 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session would be fulfilled as per calendar of the University/ Affiliating Body.
- (v) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- 6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
- 7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary to the staff.
- 8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition/permission under the provisions of Section 17(1), of the NCTE Act.
- 9. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations including inter-alia:
 - (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
