In exercise of the authority vested under NCTE Act, the Eastern Regional Committee after considering the application of **Department of Education (CTE), Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh (Assam)** for grant of recognition to the M.Ed. course of one year duration, decided to accord one year conditional recognition for the academic year 2000-2001 with intake of 10 subject to removal of the following deficiencies :

1. The institution should appoint 2 more teachers qualified as per NCTE norms. However, it may increase the intake to 25 with the permission of ERC.
2. The institution should observe minimum of 200 working days.

The University Department is advised to send a compliance report about removal of the above deficiencies to the Eastern Regional Committee by 31.8.2000.
