Order

WHEREAS, Parmarth Institute of Teacher's Education, Vill – Bamhour, Po – Shivsagar, Taluka – Sasaram, Dist – Rohtas, Bihar – 821111 (Code No. APE01191) had applied for grant of recognition for B.Ed. Course of one year duration under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the ERC, NCTE on 31.10.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS upon consideration of the written representation submitted by the institution as well as documents and materials submitted by the institution along with application the Eastern Regional Committee in its 95th meeting held on 27th-29th April 2009, came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:



Enclosures reg. Col. 5 of the affidavit given from Anchal Adhikari. Date of Registration not given. A fresh affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper (in original) regarding land in prescribed format with complete information has not been submitted.

- (ii) The Registration of deed dt. 12.02.2009 i.e. after the date of application and after the last date of application. (The land is in the name of the society)
- (iii) Certified copy of land document has not been submitted. Therefore, Certified copies of ownership/Lease documents of land in favour of the institution where the proposed B.Ed. Course will be opened as per para 8 (7) & 8 (8) alongwith English version of Land document not submitted.
- (iv) Building Completion Certificate signed by circle officer, however, it is not countersigned by the Govt Engineer.
- (v) The institution submitted building plan approved by Anchal Adhikari, however, it is not countersigned by the Govt Engineer.
- 3. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an Appeal to the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQrs and the Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-462/2009-Appeal / A230 dated 11.09.2009 had remanded back the case to ERC-NCTE for inspection of the institution to ascertain the availability of necessary infrastructure, instructional and other facilities in accordance with the norms prescribed by the NCTE to become eligible for recognition by NCTE.

- 4. AND WHEREAS, as per the directions of the Appellate Authority, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 14.12.2009.
- 5. AND WHEREAS upon consideration of the written representation submitted by the institution as well as documents and materials submitted by the institution along with application the Eastern Regional Committee in its 10/th machine hold on 20th 22nd April 2010, came to the conclusion that recognition to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:
 - (i) Experience certificate of the Principal is not as per NCTE norms. The experience of the Principal is less than five years in a secondary teacher training institution.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the institution preferred an Appeal to the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQrs against the said order of ERC and the Appellate Authority vide order No. No. 89-954/2010-Appeal/A25969 dated 27.09.2010 had reversed the ERC's order dated 29-06-2010 with direction to ERC to issue formal recognition under clause 7 (11) of the NCTE Regulations.
- 7. The original file along with other documents, the order of the appellate authority, NCIE Act, Rules, Regulation and norms and Standards were placed before the Committee in (13th ERC meeting and the Committee decided that per the orders of appellate cumulative of the orders of appellate cumulative of the orders of appellate cumulative of the orders of appellations are be issued.
- 8. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grant of recognition to Parmarth Institute of Teacher's Education, Vill Bamhour, Po Shivsagar, Taluka Sasaram, Dist Rohtas, Bihar 821111, for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) existing Regulation subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - (i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cutoff date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012 only.
 - (ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days the session is fulfilled as per the calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.
 - (iii) the institution shall, within one month of the receipt or recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Eastern Regional Committee.



- (iv)The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (\vee) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- $(\forall i)$ The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic doff for conducting the course is about it is position.
- 9. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
- 10. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars (ii)
