**Order**

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Tata College, Chaibasa, Singhbhum (West), Jharkhand, Pin-833202 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the inputs received from the visiting team and reply dated 21.2.2005 received from the institution in response to show cause notice dated 9.2.2005 issued on the basis of deficiencies observed in the visiting team report, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has proposed to function from its own building.
- iii) The institution building is shared for running another course(s).
- iv) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 lakhs, but no documentary proof towards maintaining Reserve Fund has been submitted.
- v) The institution has selected the Principal and 07 (seven) teachers qualified as per NCTE norms for the said course and copy of the list of faculty members approved by the affiliating University i.e. Registrar, Ranchi University has been submitted.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Tata College, Chaibasa, Singhbhum (West), Jharkhand, Pin-833202** for B.Ed. Course of one year duration from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **100 (one hundred)** students subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a) The institution will ensure that Principal and at least 7 (seven) faculty members qualified as per NCTE norms and duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee.
- b) The institution will ensure that documentary evidence with regard to separate Deptt./autonomy with B.Ed. Department, library, educational, psychology, and science laboratories, separate building for B.Ed. course, salary to the teaching and non-teaching staff, maintaining reserve fund as per NCTE norms be submitted to ERC, NCTE before commencement of the academic session.
- c) The institution shall ensure financial management with a separate budget for the Teacher Training Department. The Department of Teacher Education shall shift to its own building having separate campus within a period of 3 years.
- d) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an official of the Eastern Regional Committee.


- e) That the Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the Teachers and Staff be created within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/ institution, for a period of not less than sixty months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
- f) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
