Order

WHEREAS Godda College, Godda, Po & Dist.-Godda, Jharkhand-814134 (Code No. APE00437) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 12.09.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The institution will ensure that Principal/Head and at least 07 (seven) faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of the commencement of the course.
- (ii) The institution shall submit a list of teaching staff duly countersigned by the competent authority of the University within one month of the commencement of the course.
- (iii) The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by State Govt./UGC.
- (iv) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (v) The institution shall create a Reserve fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the teachers and staff within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintain in the form of FDR in favour of the management of the institution for a period of not less than sixty months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
- (vi) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda - Vs - Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqrs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-80/2014/NCTE/Insp./A87031 dated 29.04.2014 with the following observations:-

- (i) The institution is deficient in respect of both infrastructural and instructional facilities.
- (ii) The institution does not maintain Reserve fund and Endowment funds in joint accounts with Regional Director, ERC.

- (iii) The institution has not adhered to the prescribed norms regarding engagement of staff by not appointing HOD on regular basis, by keeping two positions of lecturers vacant, by not appointing part time teachers and by not giving proper service conditions to teachers.
- (iv) The management of instructional affairs is fairly satisfactory.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 05.06.2014 in response to deficiency letter dated 29.04.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) was issued vide No. 26520 dated 26.06.2014 to the institution on the following grounds:-

- (i) In the VT report dated 02.07.2005 of the inspection conducted prior to grant of recognition indicated that the proposal of the institution was to conduct the B.Ed. course for the present identified classrooms, hall, office room of the present Godda College along with other courses, and from the next session, it will be function in the new building of the Science Block.
- (ii) During special inspection of the institution, it is revealed that B.Ed. course is still being conducted in a portion of the building of Godda College. The available built up area for the B.Ed. College is only 3500 Sq. ft. as against the requirement of a minimum of 16146 Sq. ft or 1500 Sq. Mts.
- (iii) The size of Psychology lab, ET lab is inadequate.
- (iv) There is no multipurpose hall, Science lab, Mathematics centre, Art and Work Experience room and common room for boys in this institution.
- (v) Teaching facilities are appointed on contractual basis.
- (vi) The post of HOD and two lecturers are vacant.
- (vii) Original FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakh and Rs. 3.00 lakh is not submitted towards endowment fund and reserve fund respectively into joint account in the name of institution and RD, ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar.

4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 09.07.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 26.06.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 174<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2014 considered the representation of the institution and as decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) was issued vide No. 26975 dated 18.08.2014 to the institution on the following grounds:-

- (i) The institution has not submitted any proposal for shifting of the B.Ed. department in the new constructing building along with other relating documents.
- (ii) As per special inspection of the institution, it is revealed that B.Ed. course is still being conducted in a portion of the building of Godda College. The available built up area for the B.Ed. College is only 3500 Sq. ft. as against the requirement of minimum of 16146 Sq. ft. or 1500 Sq. Mts.
- (iii) The teaching faculty appointed on contractual basis. As per NCTE norms the teaching faculty must be appointed on regular basis.
- (iv) The post of HOD and two lecturers are vacant.
- (v) The size of Psychology lab, ET lab is inadequate.
- (vi) The multipurpose hall of the college is under construction.

5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 01.09.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 18.08.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 175<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqs. as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-

- (i) As per special inspection of the institution, it is revealed that B.Ed. course is still being conducted in a portion of the building of Godda College. The available built up area for the B.Ed. College is only 3500 Sq. ft. as against the requirement of a minimum of 16146 Sq. ft. or 1500 Sq. Mts.
- (ii) The institution has not submitted any proposal for shifting of premises along with other required documents and shifted the B.Ed. Department in the new premises without getting approval from the ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar.
- (iii) The teaching faculty are appointed on contractual basis. As per NCTE norms the teaching faculty must be appointed on regular basis.
- (iv) The post of HOD and two lecturers are vacant.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

6. NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to Godda College, Godda, Po & Dist.-Godda, Jharkhand-814134 (Code No. APE00437) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available at NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days of the issue of the order.
