**ORDER**

WHEREAS, GLA College, Plot No. 16931, Street No. Panki Road, Vill-Baraloja, Po - GLA College Post Office, Tehsil/Taluka- Daltonganj, City-Daltonganj, Dist-Palamu, Jharkhand - 822102 (Code No.ERCAPP264) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 26.04.2012 for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2012-2013 subject to fulfillment of some conditions mentioned therein.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No.327 of 2011 filed by Shiv Shankar Munda -Vs- Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqrs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-95/2014/NCTE/Insp./A87039 dated 17.04.2014 on reasons mentioned therein.

3. AND WHEREAS after considering the matter in various meetings, the ERC in its 175<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09.09.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqrs. as well as reply submitted by the institution dated 22.08.2014 & 30.08.2014 in response to ERC's show cause notice U/S 17(1) dated 18.08.2014 and as decided by ERC, withdrawn order was issued to the institution vide No.27331 dated 22.09.2014 from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of Section 17(1) of NCTE Act 1993 on the following grounds.

- (i) The B.Ed. Department does not have a separate campus. The college does not have its own multipurpose hall and adequate number of rooms for various laboratories and play ground required for the B.Ed. course. The Art and Craft Centre has not has not been set up. The institution has not submitted any proposal for shifting of B.Ed. Department in the new building along with other required documents as per NCTE norms.
- (ii) The teaching faculty is selected by the university on contractual basis for a period of 11 months and their services are automatically terminated on the expiry of the contract period which is against the norms of NCTE. The teaching faculty and other administrative staff must also be appointed on regular basis as NCTE/University/State Govt rules.
- (iii) The institution does not maintain Endowment and Reserve Funds, in Joint Account with ERC, Bhubaneswar.

4. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Hqrs. against the ERC's order dated 22.09.2014. The Appellate Authority vides order No.89-363/2014-Appeal/2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting-2015/3833 dt.05.05.2015 remanded back the case to ERC with a direction to consider these submissions and conduct an inspection of the institution about the availability of the requisite built-up area for the B.Ed. course and take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014. In the meantime the order of withdrawal shall be kept in abeyance.

5. AND WHEREAS the ERC in its 188<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 19-20 May 2015 considered the appeal order dated 05.05.2015 along with original file of the institution and as decided by the ERC, inspection letter to the institution was issued on 15.07.2015.

6. AND WHEREAS the ERC in its 191<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 14-15 July 2015 considered the letter dated 26.05.2015 received from the Director of Higher Education, Government of Jharkhand committed that all such requirements along with appointment of full time faculty will be complied with as per new Regulation 2014 by 31.10.2015, wherein the ERC has decided as under:

1. Recognition of the institution be continued.
2. Review the status will be taken up after 31<sup>st</sup> Oct.2015. Deficiency found if any, after inspection will be communicated to the institution, concerned University and State Government for compliance.
3. If the institution fails to comply the deficiencies, further course of action shall be taken as per norms.

7. NOW THEREFORE, the recognition of the institution viz. **GLA College, Plot No. 16931, Street No. Panki Road, Vill-Baralota, Po - GLA College Post Office, Tehsil/Taluka- Daltonganj, City- Daltonganj, Dist-Palamu, Jharkhand - 822102 (Code No.ERCAPP264)** for B.Ed. Course is allowed to continue.
