Order

WHEREAS GLA College, Plot No. 16931, Street No. Panki Road, Vill- Baralota, Po - GLA College Post Office, Tehsil/Taluka- Daltonganj, City- Daltonganj, Dist- Palamu, Jharkhand - 822102 (Code No. ERCAPP264) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 26.04.2012 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2012-2013 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (iii) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (iv) All such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
- (v) The institution shall submit the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (vi) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - a. Copy of the Application Form
 - b. Land and Building Particulars
 - c. Staff Profile
 - d. Recognition letter
 - e. Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda - Vs - Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-95/2014/NCTE/Insp./A87039 dated 17.04.2014 with the following observations:-

- (i) The institution is deficient in respect of both infrastructural and instructional facilities.
- (ii) The institution does not maintain endowment and reserve fund, in joint account with ERC, Bhubaneswar.

- (iii) The institution has not adhered to the prescribed norms regarding engagement of staff.
- (iv) The institution has not yet built a proper climate for conducting a professional programme.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not submitted any representation in response to deficiency letter dated 17.04.2014 within the stipulated period to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172nd Meeting held on 17th June 2014 considered the matter and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26528 dated 26.06.2014.

4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution submitted its representation dated 11.07.2014 and 18.07.2014 in response to deficiency letter dated 17.04.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 174th Meeting held on 5th August 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26959 dated 18.08.2014.

- (i) The B.Ed. Department does not have a separate campus.
- (ii) The college does not have its own multipurpose hall and adequate number of rooms for various laboratories and play ground required for the B.Ed. course.
- (iii) Library has a stock of 1788 books only which is less than the required 3000 books.
- (iv) The Art and Craft Centre has not has not been set up.
- (v) The staff is selected by the university on contractual basis for a period of 11 months and their services are automatically terminated on the expiry of the contract period. The staff must be appointed on regular basis as NCTE rules.
- (vi) The resources of GLA College, though available for B.Ed. Department, also are not appropriate for conducting B.Ed. programme.
- (vii) The institution does not maintain Endowment and Reserve Funds, in Joint Account with ERC, Bhubaneswar.

5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution submitted its representations dated 22.08.2014 & 30.08.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 18.08.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 175th Meeting held on 09.09.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqs. as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-

- (i) The B.Ed. Department does not have a separate campus. The college does not have its own multipurpose hall and adequate number of rooms for various laboratories and play ground required for the B.Ed. course. The Art and Craft Centre has not has not been set up. The institution has not submitted any proposal for shifting of B.Ed. Department in the new building along with other required documents as per NCTE norms.
- (ii) The teaching faculty is selected by the university on contractual basis for a period of 11 months and their services are automatically terminated on the expiry of the contract period which is against the norms of NCTE. The teaching faculty and other administrative staff must also be appointed on regular basis as NCTE/University/State Govt rules.

- (iii) The institution does not maintain Endowment and Reserve Funds, in Joint Account with ERC, Bhubaneswar.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

6. **NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to GLA College, Plot No. 16931, Street No. Panki Road, Vill- Baralota, Po - GLA College Post Office, Tehsil/Taluka- Daltonganj, City- Daltonganj, Dist- Palamu, Jharkhand - 822102 (Code No. ERCAPP264) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.**

7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available at NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days of the issue of the order.
