Order

In terms of NCTE Regulations notified in the Gazette of India, Feb 24, 1996, DIET, Thadlaskein, Jaintia Hills, Meghalaya - 793151 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for additional intake in the existing E.T.T. Course of One year duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an additional annual intake of 80 (Eighty) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- The institution has developed the infrastructure and instructional facilities required for additional intake.
- The institution has selected the Principal and 12 teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the concerned Directorate.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to DIET, Thadlaskein, Jaintia Hills, Meghalaya-793151 for E.T.T. Course of One year duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an additional annual intake of 20 (Twenty) in addition to already approved 80 (Eighty) students (making the total intake 100), subject to fulfillment of the following :

- That the institution will ensure that 12 faculty members selected by the institution and duly approved by the DERT are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the ERC within one month of commencement of the course.
- The institution will ensure that the selected teachers should acquire requisite qualifications as per NCTE norms within one year.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

4. Further, the permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies and the State Govt. etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating Board/concerned State Council/Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


