ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to **D.I.E.T., P.O. & Dist. Lunglei, Mizoram -796 701 (Mizoram)** for **Diploma in Teacher Education** course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions :

1. The institution shall function with 8 teaching staff and other supporting staff possessing the qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms and in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
3. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per NCTE norms.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the NCTE norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 8 above.

If **D.I.E.T., P.O. & Dist. Lunglei, Mizoram -796 701 (Mizoram)** contravenes any of the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall be appointed within a period of two years of this order.
3. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per NCTE norms.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work activities, should be organised as per the NCTE norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
7. Teaching log including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulation of the NCTE and shall submit the Report to the Regional Director and the Performance Appraisal Report in the prescribed form.
10. The Performance Appraisal Report should not give the extent of compliance of the institution with the NCTE norms.
