WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, State College of Teacher Education (Formerly: Nagaland College of Education), Plot no. – 067, PO – Kohima, Tehsil/Taluka – Kohima, Town/City – Kohima, Dist – Kohima, Nagaland – 797001 was granted recognition vide ERC order no. ERC/2799(12) dated 11.02.1997 for conduct of B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundered) from the academic session 1997-1998.

- 2. **AND WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the institution viz. State College of Teacher Education (Formerly: Nagaland College of Education), Plot no. 067, PO Kohima, Tehsil/ Taluka Kohima, Town/City Kohima, Dist Kohima, Nagaland 797001 has by affidavit dated 06.02.2015 consented to come under New Regulations 2014 and sought for Two Basic Units in B.Ed. course, which require additional facilities.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, it has decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to fulfill the condition namely.
 - (i) The institution shall create additional facilties that includes (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds (d) adhere to staf norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committee with required documents by October 31, 2015.
 - (ii) The applicant-instituiton for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilties before October 31. 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
 - (iii) The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016, If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

- 5. AND WHEREAS, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act. and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to the institution viz. State College of Teacher Education (Formerly: Nagaland College of Education), Plot no. 067, PO Kohima, Tehsil/ Taluka Kohima, Town/City Kohima, Dist Kohima, Nagaland 797001 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned therein before 31.10.2015. Accordingly, revised recognition order was issued vide order no.F.ERC/NCTE/(NA-S/E-1/96)/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/31792 dated 20.05.2015.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, The Director, College Development Council, Nagaland University has forwarded a letter from the Principal, State College of Teacher Education vide its letter dated 12.02.2016 addressed to the Director, Higher Education, Nagaland, Kohima which states that due to difficulties in providing space as well facilities and basic amenities to the students, the college would like to request your kind authority to permit us to admit only one unit, i.e. 50 (fifty students) for B.Ed. programmes.
- 7. AND WHEREAS, In view the above the matter was placed before the ERC in its 224th meeting held on 24th October 2016. The committee accepted the request of the State Government and decided to reduce the intake capacity for B.Ed. programme from 100 intake to 50 intake from the academic session 2017-18.
- 8. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act. 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby permits to State College of Teacher Education (Formerly: Nagaland College of Education), Plot no. 067, PO Kohima, Tehsil/Taluka Kohima, Town/City Kohima, Dist Kohima, Nagaland 797001 for conducting B.Ed. Course of two years duration with a reduced intake 50 (one basic unit) from the academic session 2017-2018 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - I. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - II. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
 - III. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 9. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
- 10. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

- 11. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
 - d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e) Fee charged from students;
 - f) Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
 - j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, If it so desires.
 - k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 12. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 13. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.
- 14. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
