Order

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 DIET, Tathangchen, Education Department, Govt. of Sikkim, Raj Bhawan, Gangtok, Sikkim - 737 103 had submitted an application to the Eastern Region Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting E.T.E Course of Two years duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in Education Dept. premises.
- The institution has selected Principal and seven teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the Joint Director, DIET.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to DIET, Tathangchen, Education Department, Govt. of Sikkim, Raj Bhawan, Gangtok, Sikkim – 737 103 for E.T.E. Course of Two years duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an intake of 50 (Fifty) students, subject to fulfillment of the following:

- That the institution will ensure that Principal and at least five faculty members duly approved by the SCERT are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the ERC within one month of commencement of the course.
- The list of teaching staff approved by the Director, SCERT shall be submitted within a month.
- That the institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition.
- That the Psychology laboratory should be developed as per NCTE norms.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by the State Govt.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the SCERT to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rule Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
