ORDER

WHEREAS recognition/permission was granted to the institute **Vivekananda Teachers Training College, Vill- Chandipur, PO – Kazigram, Dist – Malda, West Bengal – 732101** under Section 14/15 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting **B.Ed. Course** with an intake of 100 vide order No. ERC/7-75.6(II).1/2007 dated 22.05.2007.

2. **WHEREAS** on the basis of complaint against the institution namely **Vivekananda Teachers Training College, Vill- Chandipur, PO – Kazigram, Dist – Malda, West Bengal – 732101**, the Eastern Regional Committee considered the matter in its 100th meeting held on 26th-28th August, 2009, and decided to inspect the institution before taking further action U/S 17 of the NCTE Act.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the inspection of the institution under section 17 was conducted on 31.10.1009.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the ERC in its 102nd meeting of ERC whereby the committee noted that the following deficiencies exist vis-à-vis NCTE norms:-

- (i) The institution is required to improve the laboratories as per the NCTE Rules & Regulations and norms thereof.
- (ii) Science lab has no chemical & consumables in the required quantity
- (iii) Reserve Fund not maintained by the institution.
- (iv) Additional Construction work of the building is at final stage. The institution is required to submit building completion certificate.
- (v) Salary of the staff is being paid through cash.

5. **AND WHEREAS** the ERC directed that an opportunity be given to the institution to make a written representation within 30 days from the date of issue of the letter before withdrawal of recognition as per provisions contained under Section 17 of the NCTE Act on account of deficiencies as mentioned above and therefore, a show cause notice under section 17 was issued to the institution on 19.11.2009.

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5. AND WHEREAS the matter was again considered by the Eastern Regional Committee in its meeting held on 103rd meeting held on 29th -31st December 2009 and having taken into consideration all the relevant facts of the case, it was decided to withdrawn recognition for conducting B.Ed. course from next academic session i.e., 2010-2011.

6. NOW, therefore, recognition to **Vivekananda Teachers Training College, Vill- Chandipur, PO – Kazigram, Dist – Malda, West Bengal – 732101** for the **B.Ed. Course** in terms of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 is hereby withdrawn from next academic session i.e., 2010-2011 on the following grounds.

- (i) The Committee noted that at the time of inspection u/s 17 conducted on 31.10.009, it was found that the institution was not adhering to the NCTE Rules and Regulations published from time to time and conditions stipulated in the orders issued to the institution.
- (ii) Original FDR submitted by the institution towards reserve fund is made on 09.12.2009 i.e. after issue of SCN u/s 17 which proves that the institution was not maintaining the reserve fund.
- (iii) The building completion certificate submitted is not from the competent civil authority.
- (iv) As per the VT, salary of the staff was being paid in cash, which is not as per norms. After SCN, the institution has only submitted a statement regarding salary made through cheque. However, the institution has not any supporting document regarding salary made through cheque.

7. Affiliating Body/State Govt. are advised not to admit/allot any student in **B.Ed. Course** in the said institute. In accordance to the Section 17(4) of NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.



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8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.

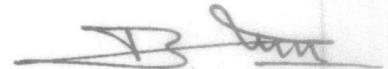
