**ORDER**

WHEREAS, Gangarampur B.Ed. College, P.O.- Kaldighi, P.S.- Gangarampur, Dist.- Dakshin Dinajpur, West Bengal- 733124 (APE00551) was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an intake of 100 vide ERC Order No. 4958 dated 15.12.2006, followed by revised order vide No. 32046 dated 24.05.2015 from the academic session 2015-2016 as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions in respect of enhancement of additional built up area, additional infrastructure, additional fund, additional staff, maintain and update website and to comply the same to the ERC.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 268<sup>th</sup> (Part-2) meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 considered the matter along with the reply dated 05.02.2019 submitted by the institution in response to Show Cause Notice and observed as under:

- (i) Show Cause Notices were issued on 15.05.2018 and 22.01.2019.
- (ii) Faculty list comprising 1+10 instead of 1+15 as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution is still deficient in compliance of appointment of required faculty. No more extension of time is allowed by the Committee.

***In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:***

The Committee is of the opinion that recognition granted to B.Ed. course of the application bearing Code No. APE00551 is withdrawn under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2019-2020.

3. **NOW THEREFORE**, recognition granted to the institution viz. Gangarampur B.Ed. College, P.O.- Kaldighi, P.S.- Gangarampur, Dist.- Dakshin Dinajpur, West Bengal- 733124 (APE00551) for B.Ed. Course is hereby **withdrawn** under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2019-2020.
