ORDER

WHEREAS, Ehiapur B.Ed. College, Vill. & PO.-Ehiapur, P.S.-Ketugram, Dist.-Burdwan, West Bengal-713129(Code No.APE00901) was granted recognition for B.Ed. course with an intake of 100 from the academic session 2009-2010 vide ERC Order No.878 dated 28.07.2009, followed by revised order vide No.32180 dated 26.05.2015 from the academic session 2015-2016 as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions in respect of enhancement of additional built up area, additional infrastructure, additional fund, additional staff, maintain and update website and to comply the same to the ERC.

2. AND WHEREAS, the ERC in its 255th meeting held on 30th April to 2nd May, 2018 considered the matter and Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) was issued on 15.05.2018 to the institution on the following grounds:

- (i) Faculty list duly approved by the concerned affiliating body not submitted.
- (ii) Blue print of building plan in original duly approved by the Govt. Engineer is not submitted.
- (iii) Building completion certificate duly approved by the Govt. Engineer is not submitted.
- (iv) No website address of the institution has been provided.
- (v) FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve fund not renewed & updated in joint operation mode.
- (vi) Converted FDRs in joint operation mode is required to be uploaded on institution website.

3. AND WHEREAS, reply dated 24.05.2018 from the institution in response to Show Cause Notice was considered by ERC in its 263rd meeting held on 15th – 16th November, 2018 and second Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) was issued on 26.11.2018 to the institution on the following ground:

- (i) Validity of earlier submitted FDRs issued by Allahabad Bank expired on 25.04.2018. The institution is required to submit FDRs of Rs.5 lakhs & Rs.7 lakhs towards EF & RF in joint operation mode as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

4. AND WHEREAS, the institution had failed to submit reply in response to Show Cause Notice within the stipulated period. The ERC in its 270th Meeting held on 25th – 26th March, 2019 considered the matter and observed as under:

- a. 1st show cause notice u/s 17(1) was issued on 16.05.2018, followed by 2nd show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 26.11.2018 with the following ground:

- (i) Validity of earlier submitted FDRs issued by Allahabad Bank expired on 25.04.2018. The institution is required to submit FDRs of Rs.5 lakhs & Rs.7 lakhs towards EF & RF in joint operation mode as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

- b. No reply received from the institution till date.

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

The Committee is of the opinion that recognition granted to B.Ed. course of the application bearing Code No.APE00901 is withdrawn under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2019-2020.

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5. **AND WHEERAS**, the order of withdrawal was not issued to the institution and the matter was re-considered by ERC in its 271st meeting held on 24-25 April, 2019 under the Agenda Item No.271.1.24 before confirmation of proceedings of 270th ERC meeting held on 25-26 March, 2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 271st meeting held on 24-25 April, 2019 re-considered the matter and observed that sufficient opportunity has been given to the institution issuing Show Cause Notice twice for fulfillment of deficiency, however the institution failed to comply the same.

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

The above decision of ERC remains unchanged. Accordingly, order of withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution and all concerned.

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, recognition granted to the institution viz. Ehiapur B.Ed. College, Vill. & PO.-Ehiapur, P.S.-Ketugram, Dist.-Burdwan, West Bengal-713129 (Code No. APE00901) for B.Ed. Course is hereby withdrawn under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2019-2020.

8. **FURTHER**, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal Under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
