ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Purbayan, Plot No.- 1653, Street/Road- West Road, Vill.- West Panchla, P.O.- Dhunki, Tehsil/Taluka- Panchla, Town/City- Howrah, Dist.- Howrah, West Bengal- 711322 has applied for grant of recognition to Purbayan Educational Institution, Plot No- 1653, Street No- West, Vill.- West Panchla, P.O.- Dhunki, Tehsil/Taluka- Panchla, Town/City- Howrah, Dist.- Howrah, West Bengal- 711322 (Code No. ERCAPP4038) for B.Ed. Course online 30.06.2015 for two year duration and hard copy received by Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE on 13.07.2015.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the affiliating body, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course vide Order No.ER-239.6.79(Part-3)/ERCAPP4038/B.Ed./2017/52857 dated 02.05.2017 with an intake of 50(one basic unit) from the academic session 2017-2018.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, being aggrieved, the institution filed W.P.(C) No.10939 of 2017 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court disposed of the matter vide Order dated 12.01.2018 with direction to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order within six weeks. The matter was considered by ERC in its 250th meeting held on 17-18 February, 2018 and accordingly, reasoned order vide No.56218 dated 27.02.2018 issued to the institution.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE HQs. against the order of ERC. The Appellate Authority vide its Order No.89-319/E-73620/2018 Appeal/13th Mtg.- 2018/27th & 28th July, 2018/69869 dated 12.09.2018 remanded back the case to ERC for revisiting the matter in accordance with the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and issuing appropriate recognition order. The institution is required to submit to ERC within 15 days of the issue of appeal order the additional list of faculty.

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6. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 262nd meeting held on 24th – 25th October, 2018 reviewed the matter in accordance with the appeal order as well as documents submitted by the institution vide letter dated 19.09.2018 and decided as under:-

*In addition to 50 intake already granted for B.Ed. Programme from the academic session 2017-18 earlier, the Committee decided that formal permission order under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 for existing **B.Ed. Programme** with another **50 intake** from the session **2019-2020** be issued to the institution, thus making the sum total grant of **100 intake**.*

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to **Purbayan Educational Institution, Plot No- 1653, Street No- West, Vill.- West Panchla, P.O.- Dhunki, Tehsil/Taluka- Panchla, Town/City- Howrah, Dist.- Howrah, West Bengal- 711322** for conducting **additional intake of B.Ed.** Course of two years duration with another intake of **50 (existing 50 intake + another 50 intake)**, thus making the total intake of **100 (Two basic units)** from the academic session **2019-2020** under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

8. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc., as applicable.

9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

10. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;

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- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, If it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

12. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

13. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.

14. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
