ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Mirza Noor Mahammad Mimority Charitable Trust, Plot No.154, 158, 147, 155, 160, 161, Vill/ P.O. - Dhaneswarpur, Temsil/ Taluka - Pingla, Town/ City - Kharagpur, Dist - Midnapur, West Bengal - 721166 has applied for grant of permission to MNM Teaches Training College, Plot No.154, 158, 147, 155, 160, 161, Vill/ P.O. - Dhaneswarpur, Tehsil/ Taluka - Pingla, Town/ City - Kharagpur, Dist -Mi-dnapur, West Bengal - 721166 (Code No.- ERCAPP4254) for B.Ed. programme online on 30_06.2015 for two year duration and hard copy received by Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE on 13.07.2015.

- AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of 232nd ERC Meeting held on 7th 8th February, 20.17, formal permission order under clause 7(16) for conducting B.Ed. course was issued vicle No. 52074 dt. 03.04.2017 with an intake 50 (one basic unit) from the academic session 20 17-18 to the institution.
- AND WHEREAS, the institution filed W.P.(C) No. 10157 of 2017 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court disposed of the matter on 12.01.2018 with a direction int er alia:

"Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner had applied for recognition of two units comprising 100 seats for the B.Ed. course, the respondent No. 2 has granted recognition for only one unit i.e. 50 seats and till date has not communicated any decision regarding the second unit comprising of 50 seats. He further submits that the respondent No. 2 has upto this date, not pointed out any deficieny/reason for not granting recognition for second unit.

Keeping in view the contentions raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the orders passed by this Court, the respondents are directed to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decided the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order within six weeks".

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

In addition to 50 intake already granted from the academic session 2017-2018 earlier, the Committee decided that formal permission Order under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 for applied B.Ed. programme with another 50 intake from the session 2018-2019 be issued to the institution, thus making the sum total grant of 100 intake.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act. 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to M NM Teaches Training College, Plot No.154, 158, 147, 155, 160, 161, Vill/ P.O. Dinaneswarpur, Tehsil/ Taluka - Pingla, Town/ City - Kharagpur, Dist - Midnapur, West Bengal 721166 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with another intake of 50 (existing 50 intake + another 50 intake), thus making total intake 100 (two basic units) from

the academic session **2018-2019** under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 5. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / B ody, the State Government etc, as applicable.
- 6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 7. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
 - d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e) Fe e charged from students;
 - f) Available infrastructural facilities:
 - g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
 - j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, If it so desires.
 - k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

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- 8. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 7. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.
- 10. The Educational institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.
- If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
