**REVISED ORDER**

WHEREAS, Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose College, 1-1B, Acharya J.C. Bose Road, Kolkata, West Bengal- 700020 (WB-S/N-3/2000 & APE00302) had applied application for grant of recognition for B.Ed. course under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993 and hard copy of the application was received on 29.12.2003 by the ERC, NCTE.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 50 from the academic session 2001-2002 vide order dated 15.06.2001 followed by order dated 15.02.2006 granting permission to the said course with additional intake of 50 from the academic session 2006-2007, thus making the total intake of 100.

3. AND WHEREAS, on the basis of implementation of NCTE Regulations 2014, Revised Recognition Order was issued on 30.05.2015 with an intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions in respect of enhancement of additional built up area, additional infrastructure, additional fund, additional staff, maintain and update institutional website and to comply the same to the ERC.

4. AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted representation dated 02.02.2018 received in this office on 05.02.2018 along with an undertaking on the non-judicial stamp paper being affidavit of Rs.100/- wherein requested to reduce the intake capacity for B.Ed. course from 100 to 50.

5. AND WHEREAS, the ERC in its 255<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> April to 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2018 after considering and examining the application along with the documents submitted by the institution, the agenda note, the NCTE Act, the NCTE Regulations 2014 including Norms and Standards, guidelines received from the NCTE Hqs. from time to time and compliance report received in response to revised recognition order, discussed the matter in detail and observed as under:

- (i) The institution submitted representation dated 02.02.2018 along with an undertaking in the form of affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper requesting to reduce the intake capacity for B.Ed. course from 100 to 50.
- (ii) The Committee has accepted the request of the institution.

**In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:**

A revised order be issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. course with 50 intake (one basic unit), which is to be followed from the academic session 2018-2019.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to **Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose College, 1-1B, Acharya J.C. Bose Road, Kolkata, West Bengal- 700020** for conducting **B.Ed. Course with an intake 50 (One basic unit)** from the academic session **2018-2019** under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

7. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc., as applicable.

8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

9. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application

- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

10. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

11. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

12. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.

13. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
