ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND, WHEREAS, the recognition has been granted to the institutions mentioned in para 5 below for the course mentioned against their name.

3. AND, WHEREAS, the said institutions by affidavit have consented to come under New Regulations and have sought for the number of units in B.Ed./B.P.Ed./M.Ed. as mentioned in para 5 below against their name, which may require additional facilities.

4. AND, WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have the desired number of units subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The applicant Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents, such as, land documents, Non Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) and Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website of the Regional Committee in-proof of having provided the additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of the premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution has failed to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/rply to SCN/complaint already submitted alongwith documents, if any, together with the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. This order shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case and in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc. as decided by the Northern Regional Committee.

5. Now, therefore, in light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to the following institutions for conducting the under-mentioned programme/intake of two years duration from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions before 31.10.2015 mentioned in para 4 above:-

6. This common revised Recognition Order is issued to facilitate the existing institutions to admit the students for the academic session 2015-16 well in time. However, the individual revised Recognition Order in respect of each institution shall follow subject to verification of the recognition status of the individual existing institution as per the records available with the NRC, NCTE. The affiliating bodies shall ensure the affiliation status of each and every individual institution prior to allowing admissions in these institutions for the academic session 2015-16. The affiliating bodies shall not extend the affiliation to such institutions whose name is not appearing either in the common revised recognition order(s) or individual revised orders.

7. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

9. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following mandatory disclosure:-

- Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
- Names of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- Names of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- Fee charged from students.
- Available infrastructural facilities.
- Facilities added during the last quarter.
- Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.

- (i) The affidavit with enclosures submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution shall be free to post and additional information, if it so desires.

10. Any false or incomplete information on the website of the institution shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.


11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there-under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **ADARSH KRISHNA P.G. COLLEGE, RAILWAY STATION ROAD, TEHSIL- SHIKOHABAD, DISTRICT- FIROZABAD-205141, UTTAR PRADESH** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.P.Ed. Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty Only) students on 19.12.2007.

AND WHEREAS, the Inspection of the said institution under section 15 was conducted by visiting team on 04.02.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 157th meeting held from March 24-27, 2010 and the committee decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of regulations 2007. Accordingly, Letter of intent prior to recognition issued to the institution on 12.04.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, reply of the institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 160th meeting held from May 18-20, 2010 and the committee decided to issue show cause notice. Accordingly, Show cause notice issued to the institution on 01.06.2010 on the following grounds:-

- The list of appointed Faculty has not been approved by affiliating University.
- The University letter regarding nomination of expert on the selection committee has not been submitted.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution dated 18.08.2010 has been considered by NRC in its 175th Meeting held on December 30-31, 2010. The institution submitted letters of approval of faculty appointments and nomination of experts by the University. Hence, the NRC, decided to issue recognition to the institution for B.P.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and in terms of section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on 26th July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166th Meeting held on 9th September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **ADARSH KRISHNA P.G. COLLEGE, RAILWAY STATION ROAD, TEHSIL-SHIKOHABAD, DISTRICT- FIROZABAD-205141, UTTAR PRADESH** for conducting B.P.Ed Course of Secondary-PE (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.


If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
