ORDER

WHEREAS the institution namely Gajadhar Gurukul Nanhakudas Mahavidyalya, Plot No. 917, Kaptanganj to Ahiraula, Wajidpur, Tahar Wajidipur, Burhanpur, Dist. Azamgarh 276141 (U.P.), was granted recognition vide NRC order File No. NRC/NCTE/Recognition/B.Ed./2016/143895-3978 dated 03.03.2016 for B.Ed. course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty only) students.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 256<sup>th</sup> meeting (Part-2) held from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 and the Committee decided to issue show cause notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued on dated 07.09.2016 on following grounds.

• As per letter no. पत्रांक-प.वि.वि./सम्ब./01-(जॉच)2016/8559 dt. 28.07.2016 received on 07.08.2016 from the Registrar, Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur, U.P., the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to the institution under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of recognition of the institution on the ground that the list of faculty duly approved by the affiliating body and submitted by the institution in the office of NRC for getting recognition is fake.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 261<sup>st</sup> meeting held from 14<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 and the Committee decided as under:-

- The institution submitted lists of faculty dt. 18.12.2015 & 24.12.2015 claimed to have been approved by the affiliating university on the basis of which it was granted recognition by NCTE to run the B.Ed. course.
- The affiliating university i.e. Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University, Jaunpur made a complaint vide its letter dt. 28.07.2016 received in NRC office on 07.08.2016 against some institutions including the present one that the list of faculty claimed to have been approved by the affiliating university on 18.12.2015 & 24.12.2015 has not been issued by the university and the university approved the list only on 29.04.2015.
- The institution has thus submitted a fake list of faculty for seeking grant of recognition.
- The list of faculty dt. 29.04.2016 submitted by the institution vide its letter received in NRC office on 07.10.2016 in response to SCN dt. 17.09.2016 cannot be accepted now since institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course by NRC on 03.03.2016 for which institution submitted the fake list of faculty.

NRC decided to withdraw the recognition for B.Ed. course under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the end of the academic session next following the date of order of withdrawal.

AND WHEREAS, the withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 30.12.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal in the NCTE Hq. against the NRC order dated 30.12.2016 and the appeal committee considered the matter and passed an order dated 21.08.2017 thereby remanding back the matter to NRC.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 274<sup>th</sup> meeting held from 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2017 and the committee decided as under:-

- In compliance with the Order dated 21.8.2017 of the Appeal Committee, NCTE (HQ), New Delhi and the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that recognition granted to the institution vide Order dated 03.03.2016 for B.Ed. course for one unit be restored.

NOW, THEREFORE, the recognition of the institution is hereby restored which was granted vide Order dated 03.03.2016 for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) to

**The institutions shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session: -**

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that “An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five years of such recognition.”
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms of staff/ qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc. shall be as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

**Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution: -**

- (i) **The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.**
- (ii) **The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution as not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2016-17.**
- (iii) **The staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.**

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
