**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Dron B.Ed. College for Women, Plot No.- 48, 58, Vpo-Khanpur Purab, District-Udham Singh Nagar, State-Uttarakhand** for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2009-2010 vide order No. F.NO. NRC/NCTE/UR-170/156 meeting/2010/18803-18809 dated 24.03.2010.

2. AND WHEREAS, the revised recognition was granted to the institution for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/UR-170/2015/104078-83 dated 25.05.2015 with the condition of adherence of provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution has not submitted compliance of Revised Recognition Order.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before NRC in its 333<sup>rd</sup> (Virtual) Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 and the Committee decided as under: -

“The NRC considered the matter regarding revised recognition order to be issued by office of NRC to the Teacher Education Institutions established prior to the notification of NCTE Regulations on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 all such institutions were required to submit an Affidavit stating that they would comply with the revised norms and standards laid down in new NCTE Regulations, 2014. As per Clause 8(11) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 ‘Whenever there are changes in norms and standards for a programme in teacher education, the institutions shall comply with the requirements laid down in the revised norms and standards immediately.....”

The NRC also considered the directions of NCTE-HQrs vide file No. F.NCTE-Reg1011/19/2021-Reg.Sect-HQ. in the matter

The NRC noted that the powers are vested to NRC under Clause- 8 (12) of NCTE Regulations, 2014, which states as under: -

*8 (12) The institution shall make the information or documents available to the Council or its authorised representatives as and when required by them and failure to produce or show any of the required documents, shall be treated as a breach of conditions of recognition.*

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In view of the powers vested with NRC under Clause 8 (11) & 8 (12) of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The NRC decided that a notification be uploaded on the website of NRC, NCTE directing to all TEIs running the B.Ed, M.Ed and B.P.Ed courses in 2014 to submit the compliance of the Revised Recognition order within 15 days of the uploading of Notification on website with documentary evidence. The institutions be directed to submit the compliance of Regulations, 2014 as under:

1. The institution shall create additional facilities as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 that include
  - a. Additional built-up area.
  - b. Additional infrastructure.
  - c. Additional Funds.
  - d. Adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014
2. Status of composite institution as per Clause-2 (b) and 8(11) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
3. Details of Endowment and Reserve Fund as per Clause 10(1) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
4. Details of Salary of staff as per Clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014
5. Hyper link of updated website of the institution having information has per Clause- 7(14) (i) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

The NRC decided that in case the institution (s) has already submitted the compliance, it may submit the copy of the same alongwith the relevant enclosures / documents, however, the staff list to be submitted by the institution should be of the staff presently working in the institution as per norms (s).”

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice u/17 was issued to the institution vide letter No. F.No.NRC/NCTE/Common Order/RRO/2021/213799 dated 30.03.2021.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has not submitted reply of Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act 1993 date 30.03.2021. The matter was placed before NRC in its 407<sup>th</sup> (Online mode) Meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 and the Committee decided as under:-

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee observed following:

The recognition was granted to the institution for B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 24/03/2010 and revised recognition order for B.Ed. two years duration with an intake of two basic units of 50 each vide order dated 25/05/2015.

The matter was considered in NRC in its 333<sup>rd</sup> meeting and the committee decided that in case the institution(s) has already submitted the compliance, it may submit the copy of the same along with the relevant enclosures/ documents, however, the staff list to be submitted by the institution should be of the staff presently working in the institution as per norms.

Accordingly, public notice dated 30/03/2021 uploaded in NCTE, NRC website. The institution has submitted reply of public notice vide letter dated 12/04/2021. The matter considered in NRC and the Committee observed the following:

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- I. The institution is required to submit proof / evidence to prove that it is a Multi-disciplinary institution as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- II. The institution is required to submit Certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority
- III. The institution is required to submit Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.
- IV. The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- V. The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- VI. The institution is required to submit Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.
- VII. The institution is required to submit Building safety certificate from the Competent Government Authority.
- VIII. The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- IX. The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- X. The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate signed by the Competent Government Authority.
- XI. The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- XII. The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.
- XIII. The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts Nationalized/Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, NRC, NCTE & Management along with duly field Bank Form "A" in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- XIV. The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- XV. The institution has not adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up to date information on its official website as per NCTE Regulations 8(14) condition for grant of recognitions as per NCTE Regulations 2014.
- XVI. Status of NAAC.



Hence, the NRC decided that Final Show Cause Notice Under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply within 7 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice u/17 was issued to the institution vide letter No. F.No. NRC/NCTE/UR-170/B.Ed./407<sup>th</sup>(Online mode) Meeting2023/223133-223134 dated 24.08.2023.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply letter dated 04.09.2023 in response of final show cause notice. The matter was considered in NRC in its 418<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> January 2024 and the Committee decided as under:-

The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the NRC after careful consideration made the following **observations**: -

1. The building plan submitted by the institute is confusing and does not meet the requirements.
2. The institute submitted a letter dated 31.7.2023 issued by the Kumaun University vide which only 12 faculty have been approved against the requirement as 16. The faculty strength is not sufficient to run B.Ed. Course with 2 units.
3. Website of the institution is not updated as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014.
4. Administrative and professional staff have not been appointed as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
5. The institute did not submit bank statements of institute, all individual faculty and other staff as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulation, 2014.
6. The institution has submitted FDR's copy along with Form "A" which is expired. The institution failed in submission of renewed FDRs as the same has been matured.
7. The institution has submitted the Fire Safety Certificate which is expired on 11.02.2023. The institution was required to submitted valid fire safety certificate.
8. The institution has not submitted the additional information as per Clause 7(14), 8(6) 10 (3) of the NCTE Regulation 2014 and Clause 2 (C) of the NCTE Regulations dated 28.04.2017.

Hence the recognition granted to Dron B.Ed. College for Women, Plot No.- 48,58, Vpo-Khanpur Purab, District- Udham Singh Nagar, State- Uttarakhand for B.Ed. course is **withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2024-2026**. No fresh admissions with effect from the academic session 2024-2026 are permitted from now onwards. However, if any student is pursuing B.Ed. programme is allowed to continue till, they complete the course. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body shall also be withdrawn.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above decision of NRC, the NRC hereby **withdraw** the recognition granted to the institution namely **Dron B.Ed. College for Women, Plot No.- 48, 58, Vpo-Khanpur Purab, District-Udham Singh Nagar, State-Uttarakhand** for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students with effect from the academic session 2024-2026.


