ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the recognition was granted by NRC to the said institution for B.P.Ed. Course vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2094/Appeal/151 Meeting//2009/12129-12136 dated 11.11.2009 with an annual intake of 50 seats from the academic session 2009-2010.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution **Baba Parvat Nath Mahavidyalaya, Parwata, Vishwanathpur, Distt. Sant Kabir Nagar, U.P.** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for one basic units in B.P.Ed., which require additional facilities.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely.

- (i). The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii). The application-Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii). The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these condition by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv). In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Northern Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

5. Now therefore, in the light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to **Baba Parvat Nath Mahavidyalaya, Parwata, Vishwanathpur, Distt. Sant Kabir Nagar, U.P.** for conducting B.P.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 for one basic units of 50 students from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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8. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure.

- (a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
- (b) Name of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- (c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- (d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- (e) Fee charged from students.
- (f) Available infrastructural facilities.
- (g) Facilities added during the last quarter.
- (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- (i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- (k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section **14(1)** of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Baba Parvat Nath Mahavidyalaya, Parwata, Vishwanathpur, Distt. Sant Kabir Nagar, U.P.**, had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE, Jaipur for grant of recognition/permission for starting **B.P.Ed Course** of **One year** duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty Only)** students on **15.02.2006**.

2. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR videography were duly considered by the NRC in its 109th 2nd Sitting Meeting held on 10th November 2006 and 110th Meeting held on 11th to 12th November 2006 respectively, the committee decided to issue Conditional Letter of Recognition to the institution and accordingly conditional recognition order was issued vide NCTE letter no. **F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/8371-79 Dated 14.11.2006**.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution has not submitted the reply to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, Jaipur and the matter was placed before NRC in its 141st Meeting held on **22nd to 24th May 2009** and the committee decided to refuse the recognition for B.P.ED course of one year duration. Accordingly order was issued vide order no. **F.NRC/NCTE/F73/UP-2094/141 MEETING/2009/10252-58 dated 10.09.2009**. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 30.07.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi. Under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aforesaid order.

4. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the NCTE, New Delhi, reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, and accordingly remanded back the matter to NCTE NRC with the direction to issue the order of recognition to the institution, in its order no. **F.NO. 89-764/2009 -APPEAL dated 08.10.2009**.

5. AND WHEREAS the matter was again placed before the NRC NCTE in its 151st Meeting held on 20th to 21st October 2009 and the committee decided process the file as directed.

6. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section **14(3) (a)** of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Baba Parvat Nath Mahavidyalaya, Parwata, Vishwanathpur, Distt. Sant Kabir Nagar, U.P.** for conducting **B.P.ED course of Secondary Physical (Level) of One year** duration with an annual intake of **50 Students (Fifty only)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions as per the clarification from the NCTE HQtrs letter No. **48-3(1)/2008/NCTE (N&S) dated 01/10/2009**:

I. **The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.**

II. **Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.**

7. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

8. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

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9. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.
10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.
12. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
13. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -
- Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - Recognition letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
14. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
