WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **B.S.M. Women B.Ed. College, Roorkee, Railway Road, Roorkee, Dist-Haridwar, Uttarakhand** for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide NRC order No. **F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/UR-186/143 Meeting/2009/5573-79** dated **06.07.2009**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the revised recognition was granted to the institution for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic unit of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order No. **F.No.NRC/NCTE/UR-186/2015 /115003-007** dated **08.07.2015**. with the condition of adherence of provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution was directed to submit the compliance report with all necessary documents but the same has not been submitted.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by NRC in its 412th (Blended mode) Meeting held on 25 September, 2023 and the Committee decided as under :-

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee noted the following:

The recognition was granted to the institution for B.Ed. one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 06/06/2009 and revised recognition for B.Ed. two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 08/06/2015.

The institution has not submitted compliance of revised recognition order .The matter considered in NRC and the committee observed the following:

- *The institution is required to submit proof / evidence to prove that it is a Multi-disciplinary institution as per clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- *The institution is required to submit Certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority*
- *The institution is required to submit Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.*

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- The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- The institution is required to submit Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.
- The institution is required to submit Building safety certificate from the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate signed by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/ Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017) , salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/ appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.
- The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, NRC, NCTE & Management along with duly field Bank Form "A" in original, verified/ signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution has not adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up to date information on its official website as per NCTE Regulations 8(14) condition for grant of recognitions as per NCTE Regulations 2014.
- Status of NAAC.

Hence, the NRC decided that First Show Cause Notice Under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on **05.10.2023** and reply submitted on **21.11.2023**.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by NRC in its 418th Meeting (Virtual) held on 23rd & 24th January, 2024 and the Committee decided as under :-

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The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP and guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee. The NRC made the following observations:-

The first Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act dated 05.10.2023 was issued to the institution for submission of compliance of adherence of conditions of NCTE Regulations, 2014. Further, a final show cause notice dated 02.11.2023 was issued to the institution. The institution submitted a reply of SCN vide its letter dated 05.10.2023.

In view of the above, the NRC decided the following: -

The Committee decided that a **Final Opportunity** before withdrawal of recognition of its B.P.Ed. course under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 be given to the institution to submit the compliance within 7 days on the following grounds: -

- (i) The institute submitted a copy of letter dated 17.10.2015 issued by the SDSU University vide which 16 faculty was approved but the same was only for the academic session 2015-2016. The institute failed in submission of latest approval of faculty. The institute submitted the proforma of faculty duly which is not approved by the affiliating body.
- (ii) Administrative and professional staff have not been appointed as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institute did not submit bank statements duly certified the bank in respect of Account of college and all individual faculty and other staff for last 3 months as required under clause 10(2) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 showing disbursement of salary through bank account.
- (iv) The institution has not submitted the additional information as per Clause 7(14), 8(6) 10 (3) of the NCTE Regulation 2014 and Clause 2 (C) of the NCTE Regulations dated 28.04.2017.
- (v) The building plan submitted by the institute is not approved and not legible.
- (vi) The institute did not submit NEC, BCC, Fire Safety, and differently abled friendly Certificate.
- (vii) The institution has submitted FDR's copy along with Form "A" which is expired. The institution is required to submit a renewed FDR's copy and Form "A".
- (viii) The institution is required to submit a copy of the affiliation orders of the last three years with intake capacity issued by the concerned affiliating body for each course being run by the institution / society.

The institution may be informed that either in case of failure in submission of compliance / reply or any further deficiency observed, final order withdrawing recognition will be issued to the institution.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on **06.02.2024** and reply submitted on **27.02.2024**.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered in NRC by 420th Meeting of NRC held on 01th and 02nd April, 2024 and the Committee decided as under :-

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The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee.

In response to Final Show Cause Notice dated 06.02.2024 issued by NRC, the reply dated 27.02.2024 submitted by the institution has been considered by the NRC and the Committee observed that the institution is still deficient on the following grounds:

- *The institute has submitted a copy of letter dated 17.10.2015 issued by the SDSU University vide which 16 faculty members were selected for the academic session 2015-2016. The institution has submitted proforma of the faculty members signed by Secretary of society in previous reply. It is seen that some of the faculty members are changed, and it is not duly approved by the affiliating body.*
- *The unapproved faculty list dated 17.10.2015 for B.Ed. faculty submitted by the institution is not substantiated with a copy of the proceeding regarding selection of the all the faculty members by the selection committee duly constituted and approved by the Competent authority of the affiliating University/body alongwith copies of certificate of academic & professional educational qualification viz. B.Ed., M.Ed., NET, Ph.D. etc. and experience of certificate of the principal.*
- *Librarian and Lab Assistant are not appointed by institution.*
- *The institution has not submitted the proof of salary disbursement to the administrative and professional staff through bank account.*
- *The institution has not submitted proof of the additional information as per clause 7(14), 8(6) 10 (3) of the NCTE Regulation 2014 and clause 2 (C) of the NCTE Regulations dated 28.04.2017.*
- *The institution has not submitted the Latest NEC issued by Competent Authority.*
- *The institution has not submitted a copy of the affiliation orders of the last three years with intake capacity issued by the concerned affiliating body for each course being run by the institution / society.*

Hence, the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the date of communication of withdrawal order. Hence, no fresh admission shall be done in next academic session i.e.2024-25.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above decision of NRC, the NRC hereby **withdraw** the recognition granted to the institution namely **B.S.M. Women B.Ed. College, Roorkee, Railway Road, Roorkee, Dist-Haridwar** for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website. www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
