**RECOGNITION ORDER | 158/48-54**

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1)/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institutions had submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for Teacher Education Course.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institutions mentioned in table below, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution against decision of clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Northern Regional Committee in its meeting held from time to time (mentioned against each of the institution) is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Programmed such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms and as per the approval of faculty given by the affiliating bodies.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercised of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a)/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to the following Institutions for conducting Teacher Education Course programme with an annual intake mentioned against their names from the academic session **2017-18** under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below:-

4. The institutions shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

- The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations as amended from time to time.
- The institutions shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtained accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five of such recognition."



- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) As per the provision of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 the following norms have been prescribed for staff/ qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc.

**NORMS AND STANDARDS FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION PROGRAMM LEADING TO THE  
BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (B.ED.) DEGREE-Regarding Staff**

5.1 Academic Faculty

For an intake of two basic units of 50 students each, that is total students strength of 200, there shall 16 full-time faculty members.

The distribution of faculty across different curricular areas shall be as under:

- Note (i) The faculty positions listed under different subject categories may teach course(s) in the Teacher Education Programme across curricular areas specified, and can cater to both foundation and pedagogy course(s). If the students strength for two years is one hundred (with one basic unit) only, the number of faculty shall be reduced to 8.
- (ii) Faculty can be utilized teaching in flexible manner so as to optimize academic expertise available.

5.2 Qualifications

The faculty shall possess the following qualifications:

A. Principal / HOD

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Arts / Science / Social Science / Humanities/Commerce with minimum 55% marks; and
  - (ii) M.Ed. with minimum 55% marks; and
  - (iii) Ph.D. in Education or in any pedagogic subject offered in the institutions; and
  - (iv) Eight year of teaching experience in a secondary Teacher Education Institution.
- Desirable: Diploma/Degree in Education Administration or Education Leadership.

B. Perspectives in Education or Foundation Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Social Science with minimum 55% marks; and
- M.Ed. degree from a recognized university with minimum 55% marks.

OR

Postgraduate (MA) degree in Education with minimum 55% marks; and

- (i) B.Ed./B.El.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks:

C. Curricula and Pedagogic Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Science / Mathematics / Social Sciences/Language with minimum 55% marks; and
- M.Ed. degree minimum 55% marks
- (i) Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks (Training/qualification in yoga education shall be desirable)



Desirable: Ph.D. degree in Education with subject specialisations.

Note: In case of B and C put together, for two faculty positions, a postgraduate degree in Sociology, Psychology/Philosophy with 55% marks, and B.Ed./B.El.Ed. with 55% marks and three year of teaching experience in secondary school shall be considered.].

D. Specialised Course Physical Educations

- (i) Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks. (Training/qualification in yoga education shall be desirable.)

Visual Arts

Post graduate degree in Fine Arts (MFA) with minimum 55% marks

Performing Arts.

(vi) Post graduate degree in Music/Dance/Theatre Arts with minimum 55% marks.

**5.3 Administrative and Professional Staff**

**Qualifications**

As prescribed by State Government/UT Administration Concerned.

Note: In a composite institution, the Principal and academic, administrative and technical staff can be shared. There shall be one Principal and other's may be termed as HoDs.

**5.4 Terms and conditions Service**

The terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of superannuation and other benefits shall be as per the policy of the State Government/Affiliating body.

6. Further, the recognitions is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory, bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body. State Govt. and also the concerned recognition Institution:-

- (i) The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & build up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non- teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation an institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014 If at any stage, it is found that the institution as not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and

the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However in the existing institution permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably the academic session 2017-18.

- (iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution. if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.


8. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure :-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars.
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

9. In case of the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognitions. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

10. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognitions as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

11. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte.india.org](http://www.ncte.india.org) within 60 days from the date of this order. The guideline for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
