5.4 Terms and Conditions of Service

The terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of superannuation and other benefits shall be as per the policy of the State Government/Affiliating body.

(vi) As Per decision of NRC taken in **240th meeting held on 20th to 22nd July, 2015**, the institution shall ensure that it has become a composite institution before the commencement of the academic session 2016-17

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year alongwith the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

7. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.india.org within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.

(iii) Appointment of teachers in physical education shall be such as to ensure the availability of expertise for teaching all course/subjects and activities related to physical education.

(iv) **Qualifications**

A. Principal / Head of the Department/Teacher-in-charge

(i) Master's degree in Physical Education (M.P.Ed./M.P.E.) with 55% marks or its equivalent grade, i.e. B in the seven point scale of letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E,F as per UGC norms.

(ii) Ph.D. in the field of Physical Education.

(iii) Eight years teaching experience out of which five years experience in an institute/college/department of physical education.

(iv) Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC/affiliating body/State Govt. from time to time for the positions of principal shall be mandatory.

B. Associate Professor:

(i) M.P.Ed. degree or its equivalent with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade i.e. B in the seven point scale of letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E,F as per UGC norms.

(ii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

Note: Any other stipulation prescribed by UGC/affiliating Body/State Govt. from time to time for the position of Associate Professor shall be mandatory.

C. Assistant Professor:

M.P.Ed. degree or its equivalent with 55% marks or its equivalent grade i.e. B in the seven point scale of letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E,F as per UGC norms.

Note: Any other stipulation prescribed by UGC/affiliating Body/State Govt. from time to time for the position of Associate Professor shall be mandatory.

D. Sports Trainers (Part Time):

Bachelors'/Masters'degree in physical education with specialization in one game/sport (as applicable) or Diploma/PG diploma in coaching in a sport (as applicable).

E. Yoga Trainer (Part Time)

PG Diploma in Yoga.

E. Dietician (Part Time)

Masters degree in nutrition or Bachelors degree in home science with diploma in nutrition and dietetics.
