**CONTINUATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Gurudham College of Education, Khedar, 6th K.M. Stone, Hissar Road, NH-65, V.P.O. –Khedar Barwala, District-Hissar, Haryana-125121** was granted recognition for B.Ed. programme of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students *vide* order No. F.NRC/NCTE/HR-1736/2010/Appeal/27674 dated 18.09.2010.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had not submitted an affidavit to come under new Regulations. The revised order was not issued to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before NRC in its 406<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> to 03<sup>rd</sup> August 2023 and the Committee decided as under: -

*The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee observed following:*

*As per decision of NRC in its 325<sup>th</sup> meeting SCN under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 was issued to the institution on 19/01/2021.*

*The institution has not submitted reply of SCN 19/01/2021. The matter of the institution considered in NRC and the Committee observed the following: -*

- *After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has not consented to come under the Regulations 2014 and affidavit in this regard was also not submitted by the institution. Hence, revised recognition order for B.Ed. course of two-year duration was not issued to the institution.*
- *The institution is required to submit proof / evidence to prove that it is a Multi-disciplinary institution as per clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- *The institution is required to submit Certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority*

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- *The institution is required to submit Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.*
- *The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.*
- *The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.*
- *The institution is required to submit Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.*
- *The institution is required to submit Building safety certificate from the Competent Government Authority.*
- *The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.*
- *The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.*
- *The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate signed by the Competent Government Authority.*
- *The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.*
- *The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.*
- *The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, NRC, NCTE & Management along with duly filled Bank Form "A" in original, verified/ signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.*



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- *The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- *The institution has not adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up to date information on its official website as per NCTE Regulations 8(14) condition for grant of recognitions as per NCTE Regulations 2014.*
- *Status of NAAC.*

***Hence, the NRC decided that Final Show Cause Notice Under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit reply within 7 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice."***

**Accordingly, Final Show Cause was issued on 11.08.2023 and the reply from the institution was received in NRC on 27.09.2023.**

**4. AND WHEREAS,** as per the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi *vide* order dated 29.08.2023, the matter was considered by NRC in its 411<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and the Committee decided as under: -

***The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC in light of order dated 29/08/2023 passed in W.P. (C) No. 10914/2023 and the Committee observed following:***

- *The NRC in its 406<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2023 issued final SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.*
- *The institution challenged the decision of NRC before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) No. 10914/2023.*
- *The Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 29/08/2023 disposed of the Writ petition with the following directions.*

*(i) Let the impugned minutes of the meeting whereby it has been decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice be treated to be communication to the petitioner no.1 calling upon the response of the petitioner no.1 on various issues, as indicated therein.*

*(ii) The petitioner no.1 is directed to submit a fresh reply within 30 days from today.*



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(iii) *The NRC is directed to consider the reply to be submitted by the petitioner no.1 in accordance with law and if it is satisfied with the explanation, let the decision to issue the Final Show Cause Notice be recalled. Conversely, in case the NRC finds that further steps are required to be taken, let the same be taken strictly in accordance with law and the Standard Operating Procedure adopted by the NCTE.*

*In view of the above the NRC decided the following:*

- *The Final SCN issued to the institution be treated as communication to the institution calling upon its response on the issues involved.*
- *As directed by the Hon'ble Court the institution is required to submit a fresh reply within 30 days from the date of court order.*

*Once reply is submitted by the institution the NRC will considered it accordance with law and SOP as directed by the Hon'ble Court.*

Accordingly, a letter was issued on 09.10.2023 and The institution has submitted reply of information with reference to the W.P. (C) No. 10914, Dated 29/08/2023, on 27.09.2023.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the said reply was considered by the NRC in its 431<sup>th</sup> (volume-2) meeting held on 9th to 11th December 2024 and the Committee decided as under: -

*The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:*

- *The recognition was granted to the institution namely Gurudham College of Education, Khedar, 6<sup>th</sup> K.M. Stone, Hissar Road, NH-65, Barwala, District – Hissar, Haryana for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 18/09/2010 and revised recognition order was issued to the institution for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 seats ( two units each of 50) vide order dated 06/06/2015.*
- *In compliance of Revised Recognition order, the final SCN was issued to the institution on 18/08/2023. The institution filed Writ Petition WP(C) No. 10914 of 2023 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court passed an order dated 28/08/2023. The committee considered the said Order in its 411<sup>th</sup> meeting and issued a letter to the institution on 09/10/2023. The institution has submitted reply on 26/09/2023.*



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*The Committee considered the reply of the institution and decided that recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 intake (two units of 50 students each) be continued.*

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in the light of above the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby allows the institution viz **Gurudham College of Education, Khedar, 6th K.M. Stone, Hissar Road, NH-65, V.P.O. –Khedar Barwala, District-Hissar, Haryana-125121** for continuing recognition of B.Ed. programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two basic units of 50 students each.

7. If the Institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, and orders made thereunder, the action including withdrawal of recognition shall be taken by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
