ORDER

**WHEREAS**, in terms of Section 14/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution viz. **Seth Banarsi Dass College of Education, Plot No.-10/24, Street No.-Pipli Road, Village-Mouja Ratgal, Post office-Kurukshetra, Tehsil/Taluka-Thanesar, Town/City-Kurukshetra, District-Kurukshetra, State-Haryana -136118** had submitted application online on 01.06.2015 to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. Course of four years duration and print out of the application was received in NRC, NCTE on 25.06.2015 i.e. after 15 days of the date of submission of the online application.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on initial scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, as decided by NRC in its 243<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2015, show cause notice before summarily rejection of application under clause 7(2)(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 was issued vide letter F. No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/2016-17/129026 dated 16.11.2015 on the following ground giving 30 days time for making a written representation to NRC, NCTE:

- (i) Failure to submit printout of the applications made online within 15 days of the submission of online application as per clause 2(b) section 7 of NCTE Regulations, 2014 whereas your online application was submitted on 01.06.2015 and hard copy received on 25.06.2015, which is beyond 15 days time limit prescribed. If its is dispatched well within time a proof to this effect shall be attached.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of reply of show cause notice from the institution, NRC in its 248<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 decided to constitute the Visiting Team and a letter in this regard was communicated vide No. F. No./NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-12758, 10031, 13048, 13902, 13312, 11163, 11534, 15444, 15665 & 15448/2015-16/135267-82 dated 21.01.2016 to the institution alongwith nine more institutions as mentioned therein.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, inspection of the institution was conducted on 07.02.2016 and the Visiting Team report was received in NRC, NCTE on 15.02.2016.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of Visiting Team report and documents attached therewith, NRC in its 250<sup>th</sup> meeting (Part-7) held on 26-27 February, 2016 decided to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/250<sup>th</sup> (Part-7) Meeting/2016/142190 dated 01.03.2016 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following grounds:

- (i) The applicant institution has not submitted any proof/evidence that it is already running BA/B.Sc. courses as per the norms of NCTE Regulations, 2014.  
(ii) Non-encumbrance certificate not submitted.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of the letter received from the State Govt. of Haryana, NRC in its 252<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> April to 02 May, 2016 (Part-2) decided to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/252<sup>nd</sup> (Part-2)/2016/154259-60 dated 22.07.2016 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following ground:

“A letter from Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh dt. 12.03.2016 reads as “Hence, you are requested not to entertain the application the applications of Societies / Trusts seeking recognition for 4 year integrated course BA B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. and opening of new B.Ed. colleges in the State henceforth and during the years 2016-17 and 2017-18”.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of reply of show cause notice from the institution, NRC in its 257<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2016(Part-3) decided that the application is rejected and recognition/permission is refused u/s 14/15(3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and FDRs, if any, be returned to the institution. Accordingly, refusal order issued to institution vide F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/257<sup>th</sup> (Part-3) Meeting/2016/159200-03 dated 27.09.2016 on the following ground:

“Government of Haryana vide its letter dt. 12.04.2016 has requested the NRC, NCTE not to entertain the applications of Societies / Trusts seeking recognition for 4 year integrated course B.A,B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. and opening of new B.Ed. colleges in the State henceforth and during the years 2016-17 and 2017-18”.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, being aggrieved with the order of refusal of recognition. the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and Appellate Authority of NCTE vide order F. No. 89-771/2016 Appeal/5<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2017 dated 18.04.2017 rejected the appeal and confirmed the order of refusal of NRC.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, being aggrieved with the orders of NCTE /NRC, the institution filed a case before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) 1296/2018 and the Hon'ble Court had disposed of the case vide order dated 12.02.2018 with by quashing the orders dated 18.04.2017 and 27.09.2016 passed by respondent Nos. 1 and 2 and directing the respondents to take a considered decision in respect of the petitioner's application before the last date i.e. 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2018, being the last date for grant of recognition for the academic session 2018-19.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, NRC in its 281<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2018 considered the matter and decided to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/281<sup>st</sup> Meeting/2018/189687 dated 26.02.2018 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following grounds:

“In compliance of order dated 12.02.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the WP (C) No. 1296/2018, the case was considered by NRC. The institution has not submitted the following documents:

- (i) Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- (ii) Non-Encumbrance certificate issued by the Competent Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.

- (iii) Approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area and the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well as the other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.
- (iv) Availability of built up area for the existing B.Ed. (6 units) and proposed course is not clear as no details were mentioned in the building plan submitted by the institution”.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of reply of show cause notice from the institution, NRC in its 285<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 decided to issue Letter of Intent under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 prior to grant of formal recognition in compliance of the provisions as envisaged in NCTE Regulations, 2014 as well as guidelines issued by the NCTE Hqrs. thereof. The following documents are to be submitted in compliance of this provision within two months from the date of issue of the letter. Accordingly, Letter of Intent was issued vide No. F.No./NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/285<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2018/195430-32 dated 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2018.

1. Copies of Fixed Deposit Receipt of Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund in the joint account of RD, NRC, NCTE & Society authority alongwith Bank form “A” verified by the Manager of the Bank.
2. Downloaded copies of the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
3. List of faculty duly approved by the affiliating body alongwith related documents. The institution is required to appoint the faculty as per the provisions of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017 dated 29.5.2017 notified on 09.6.2017 which inter-alia provides that the NET/Ph.D. (as per UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009) is now an essential qualification for the post of Lecturer/ Assistant Professor for B.Ed., B.El.Ed. and B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programmes.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of reply of letter of intent from the institution, NRC in its 289<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 08<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 decided that show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution. Accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/289<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2018/197582-83 dated 12.10.2018 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following ground:

- (i) The institution has not submitted the list of faculty duly approved by the affiliating University in r/o the proposed course.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, NRC in its 291<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2018, on consideration of judgments of the Single Bench delivered by the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi on 05.10.2018 in WP (C) No. 10551/2018 and the judgment of the Division Bench delivered by the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi on 31.10.2018 in LPA No. 619/2018 and CM Nos. 45733/2018, 45734/2018 and 45735/2018 titled Saraswati Deep College of Education Vs. NCTE decided as under:

- (i) In view of the judgment of the Single Bench delivered by the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi on 05.10.2018 in WP (C) No. 10551/2018 and the judgment of the Division Bench delivered by the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi on 31.10.2018 in LPA No. 619/2018 and CM Nos. 45733/2018, 45734/2018 and 45735/2018, NRC decided to defend the WPs regarding subsequent ban imposed by



any State Government under the jurisdiction of NRC pending before the concerned Hon'ble High Courts either Single and/or Division Bench (as the case may be). Furthermore, NRC also decided to file appeals before the Division Bench against the orders of the Single Bench which have been already delivered regarding ban imposed by concerned State Governments.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, NRC in its 295<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 06<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 decided that the application is rejected and recognition/permission is refused u/s 14/15(3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and FDRs, if any, be returned to the institution. Accordingly, refusal order issued to institution vide F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/295<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2019/200925-30 dated 28.02.2019 as under:

"In compliance of Order dated 12.02.2018 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W. P. (C) No. 1296/2018, the application of the institution has been processed. NRC decided to issue SCN on the following ground:

- (i) The total members of faculty to run the integrated course is 1+15 against which the institution has submitted 1+8 members of faculty."

15. **AND WHEREAS**, being aggrieved with the order of refusal of recognition, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and Appellate Authority of NCTE vide order F. No. 89-167/E-115750/2019 Appeal/32<sup>nd</sup> Mtg.- 2019/17<sup>th</sup> October, 2019/84059 dated 06.11.2019 remanded back the case to NRC for revisiting the matter after the appellant submits to NRC copy of required document within 15 days of the issue of Appeal order.

16. **AND WHEREAS**, on consideration of documents submitted by the institution in compliance of order dated 06.11.2019 passed by Appellate Authority of NCTE, the NRC in its 311<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 decided that recognition be granted to the institution for D.El.Ed. Course for two units (100 students) under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2020-21.

17. **AND WHEREAS**, NRC in its 312<sup>th</sup> (Emergent) Meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 while confirming the minutes of 311<sup>th</sup> NRC meeting decided that recognition be granted to the institution for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 Year Integrated) Course for two units (100 students) under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2020-21. The order may be issued after seeking a clarification from the state government of Haryana regarding ban or grant of BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. Accordingly, formal order of recognition under Clause 7(16) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 was issued vide F. No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/312<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020/208054-59 dated 03.03.2020 to the institution for conducting BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course of four years duration with an annual intake of 100(Two units) from the academic session 2020-21.

18. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 315<sup>th</sup> meeting (Virtual) held on 17<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 and the Committee decided as under:-

**"In view of Letter/Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 10.09.2018 issued from Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh/Panchkula and subsequent Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 21.01.2020, wherein ban on B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) and B.Ed. courses/B.Ed. colleges from the academic**


session 2018-2019-2020 and 2020-2021-2022 respectively, NRC has review their decision and Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/312<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020/208054-59 dated 03.03.2020 for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) course with annual intake of 2 basic units (100 students) has decided to stands cancelled henceforth.

Hence, the Committee decided that the Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/312<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020/208054-59 dated 03.03.2020 issued to the institution is hereby stands cancelled. Accordingly, an order shall be issued to the institution.”

19. **NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above decision taken by NRC in its 315<sup>th</sup> (Virtual) Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2020, recognition granted vide order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13048/312<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020/208054-59 dated 03.03.2020 to the institution viz. **Seth Banarsi Dass College of Education, Plot No.-10/24, Street No.-Pipli Road, Village-Mouja Ratgal, Post office-Kurukshetra, Tehsil/Taluka-Thanesar, Town/City-Kurukshetra, District-Kurukshetra, State-Haryana -136118** for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) course with annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2020-2021 is hereby **stands cancelled**.

20. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through “online mode” available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte.gov.in](http://www.ncte.gov.in) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE’s website.
