ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution viz. Arya College of Education, Plot No.-22/2 (2-12)23(8-0)114/3(1-16), Street No.-Rajgarh Road, Village- Bherian, Post office-Muklan, Tehsil/Taluka-Hisar, Town/City-Hisar, District- Hissar, State-Haryana -125007 had submitted application online on 03.06.2015 to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. Course of four years duration and print out of the application was received in NRC, NCTE on 11.06.2015.

2. AND WHEREAS, recommendation was sought under clause 7(4) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the State Govt. of Haryana vide letter F.No.NRC/NRCTE/Haryana State/2016-17/126905-34 dated 21st October, 2015 forwarding therewith the copies of application form submitted by the 28 societies/institutions including this institution to the Northern Regional Committee seeking grant of recognition for conducting teacher education programme followed by first reminder vide letter F.No.NRC/NRCTE/Haryana State/2016-17/131318 dated 12th December, 2015 and second reminder vide letter F.No.NRC/NRCTE/Haryana State/2016-17/138163 dated 08th February, 2016.

3. AND WHEREAS, on initial scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, NRC in its 248th meeting held on 11th to 20th January, 2016 (Part-1, 11.1.2016) decided to constitute the Visiting Team and a letter in this regard was communicated vide No. F. No./NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13035, 13283, 13621, 10528, 10530, 11008, 11025, 11184, 13218 & 14185/2015-16/133611 dated 14.01.2016 to the institution alongwith nine more institutions as mentioned therein.

4. AND WHEREAS, inspection of the institution was conducted on 23.01.2016 and the Visiting Team report was received in NRC, NCTE on 30.01.2016.

5. AND WHEREAS, on consideration of Visiting Team report and documents attached therewith, NRC in its 250th meeting (Part-7) held on 26-27 February, 2016 decided to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NBCTE/NRCAPP-13218/250th (Part-VII) Meeting/2016/142331 dated 01.03.2016 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following grounds:

- (i) The applicant institution has not submitted any proof/evidence that it is already running BA/B.Sc. courses as per the norms of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- (ii) Total built up area is less than that of the refused area as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

6. **AND WHEREAS,** on consideration of reply of show cause notice received from the institution and a letter received from State Govt. of Haryana, NRC in its 252nd Meeting held on 19th April to 02nd May, 2016 (Part-14, 02.05.2016) decided to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following ground:

(i) A letter from Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Higher Education Department,

Chandigarh dt. 12.03.2016 reads as "Hence, you are requested not to entertain the application the applications of Societies / Trusts seeking recognition for 4 year integrated course BA B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. and opening of new B.Ed. colleges in the State henceforth and during the years 2016-17 and 2017-18".

7. **AND WHEREAS,** on consideration of reply of show cause notice received from the institution, NRC in its 253rd Meeting held on 30th May to 03rd June, 2016 (Part-1) decided that the application is rejected and recognition/permission is refused u/s 14/15(3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and FDRs, if any, be returned to the institution. Accordingly, refusal order issued to institution vide F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/253rd (Part-1) Meeting/2016/152807-10 dated 06.07.2016 on the following grounds:

- (i) The reply submitted by the institution is not acceptable to the NRC.
- (ii) The applicant institution has not submitted any proof / evidence that it is offering under graduate or post graduate programme of studies in the field of Liberal Arts or Humanities or Social Science or Science or Mathematics for getting grant of recognition for 4 year integrated programme leading to B.Sc. B.Ed. / B.A. B.Ed. degree as has been mentioned in Clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and clause 1.1 of the Appendix 13 (Norms & Standards for B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. degree).
- (iii) Government of Haryana vide its letter dt. 12.04.2016 has requested the NRC, NCTE not to entertain the applications of Societies / Trusts seeking recognition for 4 year integrated course BA B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. and opening of new B.Ed. colleges in the State henceforth and during the years 2016-17 and 2017-18".

8. **AND WHEREAS,** being aggrieved with the order of refusal of recognition, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and Appellate Authority of NCTE vide order F. No. 89-548/2016 Appeal/4th Meeting-2017 dated 07.04.2017 remanded back to NRC for revisiting the case keeping in view the observations made by V.T. in reported dated 23.01.2016 and giving appellate a fair chance to submit written representation on all the points before issuing a reasoned order.

9. **AND WHEREAS,** NRC in its 269th meeting held on 26th April to 02nd May, 2017 (Part-5) considered the matter and decided to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 and accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/269th (Part-5) Meeting/2017/173558-59 dated 02.05.2017 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following grounds:

- (i) As per the VTR, ICT and language labs were not maintained. It appears that the equipment's were placed before VT from some other already running institutions to facilitate the inspection.
- (ii) Wash rooms facilities were not maintained. Woman toilets were found broken and unrepaired. Toilets were extremely unhygienic and not suitable for use.
- (iii)All books in library are old. It appears that these books were brought from other institution for the purpose of inspection only.
- (iv)The applicant institution has not submitted any proof/evidence that it is offering under graduate or post graduate programme of studies in the field of library Arts or Humanities or Social Science or Science or Mathematics for getting grant of recognition for 4 years integrated programme leading to

B.Sc. B.Ed. / B.A. B.Ed. degree as has been mentioned in Clause 2 (b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and Clause 1.1 of the Appendix 13 (Norms & Standards for B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc. degree).

- (v) Govt. of Haryana vide its letter dated 12.04.2016 has requested the NRC. NCTE not to entertain the applications of Societies/Trust seeking recognition for 4 year integrated course B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed. and opening of new B.Ed. Colleges in the State henceforth and during the years 2016-17 and 2017-18.
- 10. AND WHEREAS, on consideration of reply of show cause notice from the institution, NRC in its 272nd meeting held on 06th to 07th July, 2017 decided as under:
 - (i) Decision of the Govt. of Haryana with regard to opening of new B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for 2018-2019 be sought.

Accordingly, a letter was issued to the Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana Higher Education Department vide letter F.No. NRC/NCTE/Haryana State/2016-17/178340-43 dated 13.07.2017 followed by first reminder of even number/180612-15 dated 23.08.2017 and second reminder of even number/182802-05 dated 28.09.2017.

11. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 278th Meeting held on 19th to 20th December, 2017 and decided as under:

"In compliance of the Order of the Appeal Committee, NRC issued the letter to the Government of Haryana on 13.7.2017 followed by two reminders dated 23.8.2017 & 28.9.2017 to provide decision of Government of Haryana with regard to ban on opening of new B.Ed. and B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. College for the Academic Session 2018-19. However, the State Government did not respond so far.

• NRC further noted that the Appeal Committee in its various Orders in files bearing No. NRCAPP-6992, 6881, 7024, 6603, and 5290 made the following observations: -

AND WHEREAS Appeal committee is also of the view that when recommendations of the State Government under Clause 7(4), (5) & (6) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 are sought by the Regional Committee, the State Government should assess the institution on individual merit basis and wherever it is not favour of recognition, shall provide detailed reasons and grounds with necessary statistics. Appeal Committee noted that when the appellant applied in 2012, there was no ban by the State Government. Further the Appeal Committee is of the view that the blanket general ban imposed by the State Government can be taken into account by NCTE only before issuing any notification inviting applications for teacher education courses in a particular State for the prospective academic year(s.) Once applications are invited, the Regional Committee has no right to reject it on grounds of ban imposed subsequently by the State Government. Moreover, in the above case, the appellant was required to pay the processing fee afresh under the new Regulations. While reprocessing the application, the Regional Committee is free to ensure that the Norms and Standards as prescribed in 2014 Regulations for the teacher education programme applied for are complied with by the appellant before grant of recognition.

Since this case also falls under the same category, the NRC decided that to issue Letter of Intent under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 prior to grant of formal recognition in compliance of the

provisions as envisaged in NCTE Regulations, 2014 as well as guidelines issued by the NCTE Hqrs. thereof. The following documents are to be submitted in compliance of this provision:-

- Copies of Fixed Deposit Receipt of Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund in the joint account of RD, NRC, NCTE & Society authority alongwith Bank form "A" verified by the Manager of the Bank.
- 2. Downloaded copies of the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 3. List of faculty duly approved by the affiliating body alongwith related documents.

Accordingly, Letter of Intent under clause 7(13) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 was issued to the institution vide F. No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/278th Meeting/2017/186319-21 dated 27.12.2017.

12. AND WHEREAS, on consideration of reply of letter of intent from the institution, NRC in its 282nd meeting held on 28th February to 01st March & 03rd March, 2018 (Part-1-28.02.2018) decided that show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution. Accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/282nd (Part-1)Meeting/2018/190279-80 dated 03.03.2018 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following ground:

- (i) The institution has not appointed even a single faculty exclusively for the proposed B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. course. The list of 8 faculty members which is proposed to be shared from the B.Ed. course, have been appointed exclusively for B.Ed. course.
- (ii) For grant of recognition for two units (50 students each) of the proposed course, the institution has to appoint 16 full time faculty members duly approved by the affiliating university, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

13. AND WHEREAS, on consideration of reply of show cause notice from the institution and order dated 27.04.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) 4101/2018, NRC in its 284th Meeting held on 15th May, 2018 decided as under:

"In compliance of the Order dated 27.4.2018 in WP (C) No. 4101/2018 passed by the Hon'ble High of Delhi at New Delhi, the case was considered by NRC.

The response of the show cause notice issued by NRC dated 03.3.2018 is not acceptable.

- The institution has not appointed the HOD for the proposed course as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- One Assistant Professor Ms. Samita Prajapati duly approved by the Kurukshetra University was appointed in 2010 for D.El.Ed. course but not for the proposed course.
- Another Assistant Professor Mr. Arvind Kumar in Art & Craft duly approved by CRS University, Jind was appointed in the year 2016 for B.Ed. course but not for the proposed course.

Hence, the Committee decided that the application is rejected and recognition/ permission is refused u/s 14/15 (3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993. FDRs, if any, be returned to the institution."

Accordingly, refusal order was issued vide File No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/284th Meeting/2018/193780-85 dated 21.05.2018 to the institution.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, being aggrieved with the order of refusal of recognition, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and Appellate Authority of NCTE vide order F. No. 89-419/E-79148/2018 Appeal/5th Mtg.- 2019/19th February, 2019/76998 dated 02.04.2019 remanded back the case to NRC for revisiting the matter after the taking into account the submissions of the appellant.

15. AND WHEREAS, in compliance of order of the Appellate Authority and document submitted by the institution, NRC in its 306th Meeting held on 28th to 30th August, 2019 decided that show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution. Accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/306th Meeting/2019/205912-13 dated 17.09.2019 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following ground:

(i) In compliance of Appellate authority the appellant had agreed to replace faculty, by the newly approved faculty. It was decided that appellant institution was required to submit to NRC the particulars of HOD & newly approved faculty within 15 days of issue of appeal orders dated 24.04.2019. However, the institution has not submitted till date the particulars of HOD & newly approved faculty.

16. AND WHEREAS, on consideration of reply of show cause notice from the institution, NRC in its 308th Meeting held on 25th to 27th September, 2019 to issue show cause notice under Section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution. Accordingly, show cause notice issued vide letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/308th Meeting/2019/206238-239 dated 09.10.2019 giving 30 days time to submit reply on the following ground:

- (i) Approved faculty list from the present affiliating body is not submitted.
- (ii) Details of liberal course run by the institution is not submitted.
- (iii) Building is not friendly for differently able.
- (iv) Fire Safety Certificate is not submitted.

17. **AND WHEREAS,** on consideration of reply of show cause notice to the institution, NRC in its 313th Meeting held on 25th to 27th February, 2020 (Part-2) decided that recognition be granted to the institution for BA.B.Ed. (Four Year Integrated) Course for two units (100 students) under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2020-21. Accordingly, formal order of recognition under Clause 7(16) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 was issued vide F. No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313th Meeting/2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 to the institution for conducting BA.B.Ed. course of four years duration with an annual intake of 100(Two units) from the academic session 2020-21.

18. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 315th meeting (Virtual) held on 17th and 20th August, 2020 and the Committee decided as under:-

"In view of Letter/Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 10.09.2018 issued from Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh/Panchkula and subsequent Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 21.01.2020, wherein ban on B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) and B.Ed. courses/B.Ed. colleges from the academic session 2018-2019-2020 and 2020-2021-2022 respectively, NRC has review their decision and Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313th Meeting/2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) course with annual intake of 2 basic units (100 students) has decided to stands cancelled henceforth.

Hence, the Committee decided that the Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313th Meeting/2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 issued to the institution is hereby stands cancelled. Accordingly, an order shall be issued to the institution."

19. NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above decision taken by NRC in its 315th (Virtual) Meeting held on 17th & 20th August, 2020, recognition granted vide order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313th Meeting/2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 to the institution viz. Arya College of Education, Plot No.-22/2 (2-12)23(8-0)114/3(1-16), Street No.-Rajgarh Road, Village- Bherian, Post office-Muklan, Tehsil/Taluka-Hisar, Town/City-Hisar, District- Hissar, State-Haryana -125007 for B.A.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) course with annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2020-2021 is hereby stands cancelled.

20. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <u>www.ncte.gov.in</u> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
