SHOW CAUSE NOTICE U/S 17

WHEREAS, recognition was granted by the Northern Regional Committee to SKS College of Education, Plot No.- 50, 51, Khasra No.- 22, 16, Street No.- Kirmach, Village- Kirmach, Post Office-Kirmach, Tchsil/Taluka- Thanesar, Town/City- Kurukshetra, District- Kurukshetra- 136119, Haryana vide Order No. F. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-14850/301st Meeting/2019/203470-75 dt. 27.05.2019 for B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed. course of four years duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2020-2021.

- 2. And Whereas, the institution approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. (C) 725/2019 for change of academic session from 2020-21 to 2019-20. The Hon'ble Supreme Court passed an order dated 14.06.2019 as under:-
 - In View of the order passed by this court on 11.06.2019 in writ petition (C) Nos. 541 of 2019, the instant writ petitions stand disposed of in the same terms."
- 3. And Whereas, the matter was considered by NRC in its 302nd Emergent Meeting held on 20th to 21st June, 2019. The Committee decided as under: -

If the academic session is changed today, it will invite further rounds of litigation for the NCTE, &and the state affiliating bodies.

The State Representative of Haryana in Northern Regional Committee, Dr. Sunil Bajaj, who was present in 302nd Emergent Meeting brought to the notice of the Committee that the time schedule fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court should be adhered to stating and all the affiliating Universities in the State of Haryana are bound by the said judgment and violation may result in disrespecting the court order and which may set wrong precedence.

Further, the recognition to any institution /course is subject to the fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating university/body, State Govt. etc.

Hence, in order to avoid further litigation / contravention, NRC, NCTE decided not to change the academic session of recognition from the year 2020-21 to 2019-20

Now, therefore, the recognition given for the academic session 2020-21 cannot be changed to 2019-20.

4. And Whereas, accordingly order issued on 24.07.2019.

- 5. And Whereas, the institution approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. (C) 972/2019 for change of academic session from 2020-21 to 2019-20. The Hon'ble Supreme Court passed an order dated 05.08.2019.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by NRC in its 305th Emergent Meeting held on 12th August, 2019 The Committee decided as under:
 - In compliance with the Order dated 05.08.2019 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the case was considered by the NRC and the Committee decided to grant recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for the academic session 2019-20 in place of session 2020-21 as has been granted vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/APP-14850/301th meeting/2019/203470-75 dated 27th May, 2019.
- 7. And Whereas, accordingly order issued on 14.08.2019.
- 8. And Whereas, a letter has received form the Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh/Panchkula vide letter/Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C- II (3) dated 10.09.2018, informed regarding ban on B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) and B.Ed. courses/B.Ed. colleges from the academic session 2018-2019 & 2019-2020, and the Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigharh/Panchkula again sent the letter vide Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 21.01.2020, informed regarding ban on B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) and B.Ed. courses/B.Ed. colleges from the academic session 2020-2021 and 2020-2022.
- 9. And Whereas, the matter was considered by NRC in its 317th (Virtual) Meeting held on 22nd to 23rd September 2020 the Committee decided to issue a Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 giving 30 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice on the following ground:-

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee made following observations:

Recognition order for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course was issued to the institution vide order No. F.No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-14850/301st Meeting/2019/203470-75 dated 27.05.2019 for the academic session 2020-2021 (letter on the session was changed to 2019-2020 instead of 1920-21 by the NRC) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- 1. The institution shall adhere to the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, and ensure the following before commencement of the session: -
 - (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

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- (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017, which provides as under: -
 - An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency identified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.
 - All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to get themselves accredited by the aforesaid accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regulations.
 - The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.
- 1. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution: -
 - (i) The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliation to the institution.
 - (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions shall gradually move towards becoming composite institutions.
 - (iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognitions granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.
- 2. The institution shall maintain & update its Website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following: -
 - (i) Copy of Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition Order

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- (v) Information regarding fulfilment of norms & standards and other conditions for the course.
- (vi) No. of students admitted in different course during session 2019-20.
- (vii)Bio-metric attendance sheet of students and faculty for session 2019-20
- 3. The institution is also directed not to admit students for academic session 2020-2021 in this course i.e. BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. till further decision of NRC.

Hence, the committee decided that Show Cause Notice under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution to submit the reply accompanied with notarized affidavit of Rs. 100/- on Non-judicial stamp paper by the authorized representative of the Management within 30 days from the date of issue of show cause notice. And, copy of SCN be also endorsed to the concerned affiliating body as well as State Authority for information and further necessary action.

- 4 Now, Therefore, the institution is required to submit the representation/compliance accompanied with an Affidavit from the authorized representative of the Management. The representation along with an Affidavit must reach this office within the time specified at the end.
- In case the reply submitted is incomplete or factually incorrect or not received in this office by the date mentioned at the end of this letter, then it shall be treated as incomplete reply to the terms of this notice.
- 6. It is expected that your reply shall reach in this office through Courier / Registered AD/ Speed Post only. NCTE does not expect applicants to personally visit the NRC Office for any reason whatsoever.
- 7. Your reply, complete in all respects must reach this office within in 30 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice i.e. \\\...\\.../2020.
