#### RESTORATION OF RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely Arya College of Education, Plot No.-22/2 (2-12)23(8-0)114/3(1-16), Street No.-Rajgarh Road, Village-Bherian, Post office-Muklan, Tehsil/ Taluka-Hisar, Town/City-Fisar, District- Hissar, State-Haryana -125007 was granted recognition for conduct of BA.B.Ed/ BSc.B.Ed. programme with an annual intake 100 (two units) (50 students each) from the academic session 2020-2021 vide NRC order No.F.No.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313th Meeting /2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020.

- WHEREAS, the recognition granted to the institution was cancelled by the NRC vide order no.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/315<sup>th</sup> (Virtual Meeting/2020/209154-59 dated 03.09.2020 for the following grounds:
  - In view of Letter/Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 10.09.2018 issued from Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh/Panchkula and subsequent Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 21.01.2020, wherein ban on B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) and B.Ed. courses/B.Ed. colleges from the academic session 2018-2019-2020 and 2020-2021-2022 respectively, NRC has review their decision and Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) course with annual intake of 2 basic units (100 students) has decided to stands cancelled henceforth.

Hence, the Committee decided that the Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 issued to the institution is hereby stands cancelled. Accordingly, an order shall be issued to the institution.

- 3. WHEREAS, the institution filed W.P.(C) 6482/2020 & CM APPL.No. 22843-22844/2020 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi against the order of NRC dated 03.09.2020 and Hon'ble High Court has stay the impugned order dated 03.09.2020 of NRC vide their order dated 16.09.2020
- 4. WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 321st meeting held on 18th November 2020. The NRC in its 321st meeting made the following observation:
  - NRC has issued recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313th Meeting/2020 /208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for two units.
  - ii. In view of Letter/Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 10.09.2018 issued from Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh/Panchkula and subsequent Memo No. KW 12/16-2003 C-II (3) dated 21.01.2020, wherein ban on B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (4year Integrated) and B.Ed. course/B.Ed. colleges from the academic session 2018-2019-2020 and 2020-2021-2022 respectively.

iii. NRC reviewed the decision on Recognition Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2020 /208048-53 dated 03.03.2020 for B.A.B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed. (4 year Integrated) course with annual intake of 2 basic units (100 students) has decided to stands cancelled henceforth vide NRC's order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/315<sup>th</sup> (Virtual) Meeting/2020 /209154-59 dated 03.09.2020.

iv. The institution has filed W.P. (C) 6482/2020 & CM. APPLs. 22843-22844/2020 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi against the order of NRC dated 03.09.2020 and Hon'ble High Court has stay the impugned order dated 03.09.2020 of NRC vide their order dated 16.09.2020.

Hence NRC confirms its decision already conveyed to RD for filling appeal against the stay order of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi dated 16.09.2020, to save the future of the students..

- 9. WHEREAS, the NRC in its 338<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 reviewed its decision taken in 321<sup>st</sup> meeting and decided as under:
  - The Committee reviewed the matter and decided that the above decision taken by NRC in its 321st meeting held on 18th November, 2020 may be treated as withdrawn with immediate effect.
- 10. **WHEREAS**, the above decision of the NRC was informed to the institution accordingly vide NRC letter No.F.No.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218-B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed./2021/215228-29 dated 12.08.2021
- 11. WHEREAS, the institution filed a writ petition filed W.P.(C) 6482/2020 & CM APPL.22843/2020, 22844/2020 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi against the order of NRC dated 03.09.2020. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed an order dated 04.05.2023 i.r.t. W.P.(C) 6482/2020 & CM APPL.22843/2020, 22844/2020 as follows:
  - The respondent no.2 shall issue consequential information to all concerned, intimating them that the earlier order of cancellation of recognition has been withdrawn and the petitioners-institution stood recognized. Let the name of the petitioner-institution be also reflected as recognized institutions in the official web portal of the respondent No.2, if any maintained.
  - Let the fresh restoration order of recognition be also issued by the respondents.
- 12. **WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 399<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023. The NRC in its 399<sup>th</sup> carefully considered the matter in light of Court order dated 04/05/2023 passed in W.P. (C) 6482/2020 and the NRC noted the following:
  - The recognition granted to the institution was cancelled by NRC vide order dated 03/09/2020. The institution challenged the cancellation before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the W.P. (C) 6482/2020 clubbed with W.P. (C) 6396/2020.
  - The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 14/09/2020 stayed the operation of order dated 03/09/2020 of the NRC.
  - The matter was considered by NRC in its 338<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and further decided that earlier decision for cancellation of recognition be reviewed. Accordingly, the order dated 3/9/2020 was treated to be withdrawn with immediate effect.

In view of the above facts and the Hon'ble Court order dated 04/05/2023 the NRC decided the following:

- The fresh restoration order be issued to the institution.
- The name of the institution be reflected as recognized institution on the website of the NCTE.
- The affiliating University/ State Govt may accordingly be intimated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Northern Regional Committee hereby restore recognition/permission granted to the institution viz. Arya College of Education, Plot No.-22/2 (2-12)23(8-0)114/3(1-16), Street No.-Rajgarh Road, Village- Bherian, Post office-Muklan, Tehsil/ Taluka-Hisar, Town/City-Hisar, District-Hissar, State-Haryana -125007 for conduct of for conduct of BA.B.Ed/BSc.B.Ed. programme with an annual intake 100 ( two units) (50 students each) from the academic session 2020-2021 vide NRC order No.F.No.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13218/313<sup>th</sup> Meeting /2020/208048-53 dated 03.03.2020.

The institution shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 as amended from time to time and ensure the following before commencement of the session:-

- i. The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations as amended from time to time.
- ii. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- iii. The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017
- iv. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- v. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 13. Further the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, Affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc., as applicable.
- 14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance-Appraisal Report (PAR) at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 15. The institution shall maintain its own website with hyperlink to the NCTE website uploading the required information / documents as per clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended time to time.
- 16. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

- 17. If the Institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, and orders made of issued there under, the action including withdrawal of recognition shall be taken by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
- 18. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act., 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website <a href="www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filling appeal may be seen on NCTE's Website.
