ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND, WHEREAS**, the recognition has been granted to the institutions mentioned in para 5 below for the course mentioned against their name.

3. **AND, WHEREAS**, the said institutions by affidavit have consented to come under New Regulations and have sought for the number of units in B.Ed./B.P.Ed./M.Ed. as mentioned in para 5 below against their name, which may require additional facilities.

4. **AND, WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have the desired number of units subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

- The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- The applicant Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents, such as, land documents, Non Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) and Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website of the Regional Committee in proof of having provided the additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of the premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution has failed to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint already submitted alongwith documents, if any, together with the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. This order shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case and in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc. as decided by the Northern Regional Committee.

5. **Now, therefore**, in light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to the following institutions for conducting the under-mentioned programme/intake of two years duration from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions before 31.10.2015 mentioned in para 4 above:-

6. In respect of those cases where recognitions has already been withdrawn by NRC, NCTE, this revised order will be treated as cancelled.

7. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.


9. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following mandatory disclosure:-

- Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
- Names of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- Names of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- Fee charged from students.

- (f) Available infrastructural facilities.
- (g) Facilities added during the last quarter.
- (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- (i) The affidavit with enclosures submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution shall be free to post and additional information, if it so desires.

10. Any false or incomplete information on the website of the institution shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there-under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Basant Ram Nageena Mahavidyalaya, VPO- Dharaon, Tehsil – Sakaldiha, District - Chandoli, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred Only) students on 31.12.2007.

AND WHEREAS, the deficiency letter issued to the institution on 09.04.2009 and the reply of the institution (in response to deficiency letter) was considered by the committee in its 138th Meeting held on from March 14th to 16th, 2009 and committee decided to ask the institution to submit the CLU from the competent authority as prescribed by U.P. Govt. norms on prescribed format/ procedure. Accordingly letter was issued to the institution on 21.03.2009 on the following points:-

- CLU submitted by the Tahshildar in respect of the land use is negative.

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated 14.05.2009 of the institution (in response to NRC's letter dated 21.03.2009) was considered by the committee in its 141st meeting held from May 22nd to 24th, 2009 and committee decided to constitute the VT. Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution on 01.06.2009. The inspection of the institution under section 14 was conducted on 15.06.2009.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, input received from the visiting team in the form of report/ videography and the input received from, recommendation of the State Government, the Northern Regional Committee in its 143rd Meeting held from June 27th to 29th, 2009 decided to issue Show Cause Notice on certain deficiencies. Accordingly show cause notice was issued to the institution on 03.07.2009 on the following grounds:-

- The Faculty is not appointed through duly constituted selection committee as per NCTE norms.
- Eight computers are not sufficient for 100 students.
- The maintenance of building is to poor.
- The toilets for boys are not usable.
- The number of titles in the library is not as per NCTE norms.
- Language learning facilities are not available.

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated 09.10.2009 of the institution (in response to NRC's letter dated 03.07.2009) was considered by the committee in its 147th meeting held on August, 16th and 17th, 2009 and committee decided to refuse the recognition for B.Ed. course. Accordingly, refusal order was issued to the institution on 29.09.2009 on the following grounds:-

- Faculty has not yet been appointed through duly constituted selection committee as per NCTE norms for B.Ed.
- Language learning facilities are still not adequate.
- The number of titles in the library is not as per NCTE norms.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 29.06.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council vide order dated 19.11.2010 and accept the appeal and reversed the NRC's order dated 29.09.2009 with direction to NRC for issuance of letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations. Accordingly, letter of intent under clause 7(9) was issued to the institution on 29.12.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution dated 28.02.2011 and the original file was considered by NRC in its 180 Meeting held from 23rd March to 26th March, 2011, 31st March to 1st April and 9th April to 11th April 2011 and NRC decided that the **Formal Recognition order under clause 7(11) of the NCTE Regulation, 2009 be issued**. The fixed deposit receipt towards Endowment Fund and Reserve Fund be returned to the Institution for converting them into Joint Account.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Basant Ram Nageena Mahavidyalaya, VPO- Dharaon, Tehsil – Sakaldiha, District - Chandoli, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. One year Course with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred Only) students from the academic session 2011-2012 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated alongwith an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

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Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.
