Withdrawal Order

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Adarsh Sangeet Vidyalaya, E-331 A, East of Kailash, New Delhi -110065 had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for seeking permission to the Daisy Dales Sr. Secondary School, E-331 A, East of Kailash, New Delhi -110065 for N.T.T. course on 03.02.2004. The institution was granted recognition on vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/14330-36 on dated 24.01.2007.

AND WHEREAS, the matter of the institution was placed in its 190th meeting of the NRC held from December 6th to 8th, 2011 whereby it was observed that the land has been leased by DDA for running Nursery School Building. Hence, NRC decided that VT be constituted under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 for verifying land documents, infrastructure facilities, instructional facilities including qualified staff, their salary payment mode etc as per NCTE norms.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was place in its 198th meeting of the NRC held from 20th April, 2012 to 27th April, 2012 and it was decided that Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the Institution on the above point before withdrawal of recognition of the institution. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.05.2012 on the following grounds :-

- The institution was granted recognition for NTT course with an annual intake of 50 students vide NCTE/NRC order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/3580 dated 24.1.2007. The land was allotted to the society by DDA on a perpetual lease for running a Nursery school and for starting any other course necessary permission of DDA is essential.
- The institution has not submitted the permission of DDA for starting NRR course.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was finally considered by NRC in its 206th meeting held from October 17-15, 2012 and Committee discussed and considered the case in detail and following observations were made:-

- Reply of Show Cause Notice has been received on 18.06.2012. the reply is not satisfactory:-

Hence, NRC decided that Grant of recognition for NTT course is withdrawn because the land was allotted to the society by DDA on a perpetual lease for running a Nursery School. The institution has not yet submitted the permission of DDA for running NTT Course on this land.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 2009, the Northern Regional Committee hereby withdraw the above recognition granted to Daisy Dales Sr. Secondary School, E-331 A, East of Kailash, New Delhi -110065 for N.T.T. course on the grounds mentioned above with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of this order.

If the institution is not satisfied with order it may prefer an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the 'online mode' available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.

3. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- (a) The institution shall maintain the teaching staff strength as per the NCTE norms & standards for its respective approved courses.
- (b) The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- (c) The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
- (d) The Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. three lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the Managements/Institutions.
- (e) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC/SCERT (as per the approved course) and State Government etc.
- (f) The institutions shall submit to Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education / SCERT as per the approval courses about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (g) The institutions shall regularly update their website.

- (h) The institutions intending to run the teacher training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to shift to their permanent building. They are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.

4. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations and / or under made or issue there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Selection 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. The NCTE Hqrs. may also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.
