**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution **Maharshi Valmiki College of Education, Shakarpur, Delhi - 110092** was recognized by NRC vide its Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/DH-368/14179-185 dated 04.07.2012 for B.Ed. course for 185 seats.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution **Maharshi Valmiki College of Education, Shakarpur, Delhi - 110092** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed. which require additional facilities.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely.

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The application-Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these condition by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Northern Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

5. **Now therefore**, in the light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to **Maharshi Valmiki College of Education, Shakarpur, Delhi - 110092** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

- (i) The affidavit wit closure submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution sl be free to post additional relevant information, if is so desires.
- (k) Any false or inc olete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contr nes any the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made a issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recogn a by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

**ORDER**

WHEREAS, Maharshi Valmiki College of Education, Shakarpur, Delhi-110092 had applied for grant of recognition for additional intake in B.Ed Course of one year duration under section 14(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the NRC, NCTE (Jaipur) on 09.03.2007.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 120 students vide NRC, NCTE Order No.F-3/DH-02/B.Ed./2000/5937-44 dated 15.07.2000.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 24.12.2010 sent information regarding implementation of Government of India policy on OBC's reservation, the number of B.Ed students has been increased from 120 to 142 (18% i.e. 22 seats) with effect from the academic session 2008-09.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 182<sup>nd</sup> meeting held from 15<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>th</sup> May, 2011. The Visiting Team Report and CD taken on the occasion has been carefully perused and following observations made:-

- The institution gradually increased its seats from 120 to 185 in accordance with the provision of the Central Act regarding 27% OBC reservation, without altering the existing available seats to the general category. The same has been found in order as the institution had the matching additional facilities in terms of faculty and other infrastructure.

As, such NRC decided to increase the intake to the B.Ed Course to 185 in accordance the provision of the Central Act.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise the powers referred under section 14/15 (3) (a) NCTE Act 1993, the Northern Regional Committee is hereby grant permission to B.Ed Course for increase intake in exiting B.Ed course from 120 to 185 seats under clause 7(11)of NCTE regulation 2009 subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- ii. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- iii. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a self-appraisal report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
8. The institution shall maintain & update its Website as per provision of NCTE regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
  - i. Copy of the Application Form.
  - ii. Land and Building Particulars
  - iii. Staff Profile
  - iv. Recognition letter
  - v. Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

9. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

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10. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE, Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

11. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-11, I Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order, The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.
