Withdrawal Order

WHEREAS, in terms of section 15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Kamal Educational & Welfare Society, P.O. – Vikaspuri, Town/City – New Delhi -110018, Delhi** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for seeking permission to the **Trinity Institute of Higher Education, D-Block, Adj. to Kamal Public School, Vikas Puri, Delhi-110018** for B.Ed. course of one year duration for an intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students on 12.01.2007. The recognition was granted to the institution for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake 100 (One Hundred Only) students vide NRC order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/DH-392/2008/50540-46 dated 14.05.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 137th meeting held from 28th February to 01st March, 2009 and it was observed that the committee considered the whole case along with the direction of Hon'ble High Court. The committee also observed the details of the factual position submitted by the Regional office to the Advocate and NCTE Hqrs, Delhi and decided to issue the Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act to withdraw the recognition on the basis of the points mentioned in the letter of Regional office submitted to Advocate and NCTE Hqrs. Accordingly, notice was issued to the institution on 12.03.2009 and the institution submitted its reply on 20.04.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 190th meeting held from December 06-08, 2011 and it was observed that the land has been leased by DDA for running Middle School. Hence, NRC decided that VT be constituted under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 for verifying land documents, infrastructure facilities, instructional facilities including qualified staff, their salary payment mode etc. as per NCTE Norms. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was conducted u/s 17 on 14.02.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the VTR was considered by NRC in its 195th meeting held from March 13-16, 2012 and it was observed that the Institution had submitted application for B.Ed. course on November 12, 2007 when the Regulations of December 2007 were not effective. Hence no action is required.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was again placed before NRC in its 198th meeting held from April 20-27, 2012 and following observations have been made:-

- The land has been allotted to the institution by the DDA on a perpetual lease basis.
- As per clause 13 of this perpetual lease document, the land was leased out only for running the middle school. "The clause further require permission of lessor if the same is to be used for a purpose other than middle school only with terms and conditions of lessor".
- The institution has not submitted the permission of lessor for use of the land/building for running B.Ed. programme.
- The institution has not submitted the list of qualified faculty duly approved by affiliating body.
- The institution did not submit details of salary paid to teachers as per clause 4(v)(d)/4(a) (d) of NCTE norms for respective teacher training course with supporting document.

Hence, NRC decided that Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the Institution on the above point before withdrawal of recognition of the institution. Institution be directed to submit the reply as per the provisions of NCTE Act, 1993 Rules & Regulations within 30 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 11.06.2012. Reply of the institution dated 04.07.2012 in response to the Show Cause Notice received in NRC office on 04.07.2012.

AND WHEREAS, The matter was again considered by NRC in its 201th meeting held from July 12-15, 2012 and Committee discussed and considered the case in detail and following observations were made:-

- Land has been allotted to the institution by DDA for running the middle school.
- Institution has not submitted permission of lesser for use of the land/building for running B.Ed. programme. Reply submitted by the institution is not acceptable.

Hence, NRC decided that the recognition for the said course be withdrawn under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the above point.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 2009, the Northern Regional Committee hereby withdraw the above recognition granted to Trinity Institute of Higher Education, D-Block, Adj. to Kamal Public School, Vikas Puri, Delhi-110018 for B.Ed. course of one year duration for an intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students on the grounds mentioned above with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of this order.


If the institution is not satisfied by the above order they can prefer an appeal to the Council (NCTE, New Delhi) in terms of section 18 of of NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.

ORDER**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Trinity Institute of Higher Education, D-Block, Vikas Puri, New Delhi - 110018 has submitted an application (code No. 05040) to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred only) students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition, Trinity Institute of Higher Education, D-Block, Vikas Puri, New Delhi - 110018 for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students under clause 7(12) of Regulation dated 13.01.2006 subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (i) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Northern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
