ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section **15(1)** of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sirifort College of Computer Technology and Management, 8 Industrial Area, Sector-25, Rohini, Delhi**, had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE, Jaipur for grant of recognition/permission for starting **ETE** Course of **Two year** duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty Only)** students on **17.06.2008**.

2. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution as well as other documents and reply to show cause notice submitted by the Institution along with VTR, videography were duly considered by the NRC in its 139th meeting held on 10th to 12th April 2009, the committee decided to issue letter of intent prior to recognition to the institution and accordingly letter of intent prior to recognition was issued vide NCTE letter no. **F.NO.NRC/NCTE/F-7/DH-411/139 Meeting/2009/2460-61 Dated 17.05.2009**.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution submitted its reply to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE on 24.6.2009 and the matter was placed before NRC in its 142nd Meeting held on 14th to 16th June 2009 and the committee decided to seek clarification from the institution on the following grounds:

- The selected Principal is not qualified.
- One more lecturer with qualification as per NCTE norms is to be appointed.

4. AND WHEREAS a clarification letter was issued vide letter no. **F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/DH-411/142 MEETING/2009/5165** dated 25.06.2009 and the applicant institution submitted the reply on 24.06.2009 and the matter was placed before NRC in its 143rd Meeting held on 27th to 29th June 2009 and the committee decided to refuse the application for ETE Course of two year duration. Accordingly order was issued vide order no. **F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/DH-411/143 Meeting/2009/6519-25 dated 16.07.2009**. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 16.07.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi. Under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aforesaid order.

5. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the NCTE, New Delhi, reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal on the ground that the Principal was having 5 Year 3 months experience in elementary teacher education institution and NRC's decision dated 27th to 29th June 2009. Accordingly the NRC's order dated 16.07.2009 was reversed, vide order no. **F.NO. 89-687/2009 APPEAL/ A2215 dated 11.09.2009**.

6. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section **15 (3) (a)** of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Sirifort College of Computer Technology and Management, 8 Industrial Area, Sector-25, Rohini, Delhi** for conducting ETE Course of **Elementary (Level)** of **Two year** duration with an annual intake of **50 Students (Fifty only)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions as per the clarification from the NCTE HQ's letter No. File No. 48-3(1)/2008/NCTE (N&S) dated 01/10/2009:

1. The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.

II. Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body

7. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Non-tenet Regional Committee.
8. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
9. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.
10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.
12. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
13. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -
 - Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - Recognition letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
14. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
