ORDER

24 MAY 2007

WHEREAS **Tsunami College of Education, 7/339 Subash Nagar, Gurgaon, Haryana** submitted an application seeking grant of recognition to B.Ed course from the session 2005-2006.

AND WHEREAS, a team of experts conducted the inspection of the institution on 23.12.2006. The visiting team report and the original file and related documents were placed in the meeting of NRC, held on 18- 19th January, 2007 (113th meeting). The Regional committee decided that a letter be addressed to the Institution asking for completion of the building infrastructural and instructional facilities and also decided to send a second visiting team for inspection after receipt of reply from the institution.

AND WHEREAS a letter was sent to the institution on 29.01.2007 informing the decision of the committee and asked the institution to submit documents in r/o completion of building and after providing of required infrastructural and instructional facilities. The institution replied vide letter dated 29th January, 2007 that all the facilities had been created and requested for causing inspection of the institution. Then a second visiting team was constituted and deputed to conduct inspection on 07.02.2007.

AND WHEREAS The original file of the institution, 2nd VT Report, Video CD, other related documents, Act of NCTE 1993, Regulations and guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were placed before the NRC in its 114th Meeting dated 21st-22nd February 2007. The Regional Committee noted several deficiencies.

AND WHEREAS a letter dated 02.03.2007 was sent to the institution to give opportunity to make good of the deficiencies and make a written representation within 30 days from the date of issue of the letter before refusal of recognition as per the provisions contained under section 14 of the NCTE Act on account of deficiencies. In response to this letter the institution submitted a reply vide letter dated 22.03.2007

AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 115th meeting held on 25-26th March, 2006, considered the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt. 22.03.2007 and found that the institution has not responded as per letter dated 22.03.07 and therefore letter dated 10.04.2007 was issued to the institution as per the NRC decision to submit appropriate reply.

AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 116th meeting held on 20th -21st April, 2007, considered the reply submitted by the institution by fax along with all related documents, original file of the institution and noted that institution has not fulfilled the requirements laid down under NCTE Regulations for grant of recognition. The application of the institution was received in 20.07.2005 when old regulation were in vogue. However, the committee decided to examine the application of the institution as per old regulation as well as new regulations to extent the benefit where ever it was possible to set up the institution.

1. As per Appendix 7 of old Regulations dated 13th Nov 2002, Article 7 (d) "*The Management / Institution shall, at the time of making application, have in its possession, adequate land / land and building on ownership basis free from all encumbrances. Govt land acquired on long term lease as per the law of the concerned State / UT will also be considered valid for the purpose*"

As per new Regulations dated 27th Dec 07 Gazetted on 13th Jan 06, the institution must have land in possession either on ownership basis or on lease for a period of not less than 30 years. The Tsunami College of Education has submitted only notarized documents on Rs. 5/- Stamp paper, which is not a legal Lease Deed and thus **the institution is not in possession of land either on lease basis or on ownership basis as prescribed in old/new Regulations.**

2. As per Appendix 7 of old Regulations dated 13th Nov 2002, Article 7 (a) and (b) "*Adequate number of classrooms, hall, laboratory space for conducting extra curricular activities for approved intake of 100 students, separate rooms for the principal, faculty members, office for the administrative staff and a store*"

As per new regulation for B. Ed course dated 20th July 2006, Para 5.1.1 - 1500 sq. mtrs built up area is required whereas, the institution has submitted the building plan having only six rooms out of which four rooms have been earmarked as classrooms, one as library and one as Science lab, **so the institution is not having adequate space/ built up area as prescribed in old/new Regulations.**

3. In the Affidavit dated 22nd March 2007, Sr. No. 06, the institution has stated "Website of Tsunami college of Education is being launched by Director General, National Informatics Centre, Ministry of Communication and Information Technology. It shows that the website is yet to be launched. Whereas, the NCTE Regulations dated 27th Dec 05, Gazetted on 13th Jan 06 prescribe that the institution should have its own website as per Article 7 (6) of the Regulations. The committee also noted that the institution has not submitted any concrete evidence that all facilities have been made available in spite of several communications to fulfill the short comings mentioned in the visiting team reports.



Keeping in view the above facts, the Committee decided to Refuse grant of recognition for B. Ed course U/s 14 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it may prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
