ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **M.D. College, 8A/1-AB, Lawyer's Colony, Bye Pass Road, Dayal Bagh, Agra, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council For Teacher Education for grant of recognition for starting **B.Ed. of One year** from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **120 (One Hundred Twenty)** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following :-

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- (iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5,00,000.00 and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3,00,000.00.
- (iv) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal / Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **M.D. College, 8A/1-AB, Lawyer's Colony, Bye Pass Road, Dayal Bagh, Agra, Uttar Pradesh** for **B.Ed. of One Year** from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred)** students subject to fulfilment of the following :-
